Topics/Issues/Concerns

- Ms. Whitley opened the meeting by taking roll and providing the agenda
- Ms. Whitley opened the meeting with the call for discussion on a school wide behavioral plan she has requested that grade levels come to the next meeting with ideas for a consistent school wide plan
- Mrs. Smith requested that a water cooler be placed in the 4-5 workroom
- Mrs. Tarlton inquired when LLI (Leveled Literacy Intervention K-3) will start Mrs. Thomas informed the group that the positions will be posted and will begin in December 2015
- Mrs. Thomas informed the group that Teacher Assistants will only cover K-3rd grade - TAs in 4th and 5th will be eliminated (grade level ratios: K 2:3, 1st & 2nd 2:4, 3rd 1:3)
- Mrs. Thomas mentioned that tutors will be hired to assist in 4th and 5th grade

- Mrs. Tarlton requested mulch paths installed on the playground to prevent students from walking in and tracking mud throughout the school Mrs. Thomas mentioned that a plan will need to be drawn before paths can be installed
- Mrs. Tarlton asked Mrs. Thomas about our school tutoring policy Teachers are not allowed to charge for tutoring students at school
- Mrs. Willing asked if the prohibition on tutoring was due to insurance Mrs. Thomas mentioned that insurance policies would be cost prohibitive to cover the teachers interested in tutoring on school property
- Mrs. Willing questioned the difference between tutoring for free and being paid for tutoring liability for the county?
- Mrs. Wylie raised a concern about the sticker machine causing students to arrive at class late and be disruptive in the hall before school
- Mrs. Thomas mentioned that the sticker machine does not cost the school any money and it receives a percentage of all sales
- Mrs. Seighman mentioned that the stickers are causing littering in the hall and students are sticking them on the floors and walls
- Mrs. Thomas suggested tying the stickers (ability to go to the sticker machine) to behavior
- Mrs. Wylie asked if the school could participate in a box-top drive so sitebase could purchase the fence communication cups (school competition)
- Mrs. Whitley asked Mrs. Thomas as to when the electric sign would be installed She informed the group that due to all of the wet weather, all sign installs have been delayed
