MRHS Site-Based Team Meeting Minutes January 29, 2020

I. Dual Enrollment / South Piedmont Community College Matters

Team discussed a variety of details related to MRHS student participation in SPCC/dual enrollment/College & Career Promise courses. Student participation has increased exponentially over the last six years.

The team decided that for the 2020-21 school year, that all Juniors must do all SPCC online coursework at MRHS in the distance lab.

Seniors will have the opportunity to do SPCC online coursework off-site with parent permission, if the student has successfully completed an SPCC online course previously. Prior success is defined as having earned transferable college credit, which is a C or higher.

II. Attendance Policy Matters

To supplement the district's current student attendance policy, the following decisions were made:

- -Team decided that attendance notes must be returned within 5 business days of any absence(s).
- -Team decided that a limit of 3 absences per course will be excusable by parent note related to sickness. (Extenuating circumstances such as documentation of a chronic condition will be taken into consideration.)
- -These supplements to policy will allow us to determine exam exemption status more effectively and for us to function more efficiently overall with attendance-related procedures. The current policy leaves room for parents to submit an unlimited number of parent notes related to sickness many weeks or months after the absences occurred.
