- a. Enrolled 108 new students this year

- c. 132 sts participating in College & Career Promise Program this year, taking a total of 286 classes
- d. 588 sts will be taking appx 1230 AP Exams this year (up from 550 sts taking 1075 exams last year)
- e. 108 sts in the IB Diploma Program currently
- f. Attendance last year's attendance rate was 96% highest in recent MRHS history for 1st semester, we only had 4 students who had major attendance issues to be evaluated much less than typical semesters

iii. Room Sharing Arrangements - feedback regarding approach to that

- Once you are floating, you might as well float all blocks
