- What should be marketed as our "identity"
 - Vertical alignment field trips HS students teaching the elementary and middle students
 - Reciprocal learning
 - French students are beginning to visit elementary schools to show the opportunities available
- Variety of Clubs offered strengthen relationships between upper students and lower students; students giving back to the community
- Cluster wide football games, Run4theRidge; Peer2Peer tutoring (HS to MS) look into HS tutoring for elementary as well
- Academically Option Nights presented to younger students
 - Would like Marvin Ridge Middle School to offer more languages (Cuthbertson offers 3; Marvin only offers 2)
 - o Increase language offerings in elementary schools

 - Students from other schools feel Marvin Ridge students are very competitive with each other; within the school, students feel some classes are not acceptable because those classes will lower their class ranks/GPAs.
