#### Requirements for earning an Academic Letter:

- The student must be in the 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade.
- The student must have an overall semester average of 90, computed by averaging the grades received in all courses in which the student is enrolled. The student may earn no semester grade less than "85" to be considered.

Powerschool issue of parents getting notification that their students is tardy but it appears as an absences online. Dr. Harris mentioned that the 15 minute rule is what is making it an absence. If a student misses more than 15 min in a class, it is counted as an absence.
