11th Graders/Juniors ONLY: The PSAT / NMSQT held on October 12, 2022 (Wednesday) will be OPTIONAL for any 11th grader who wishes to participate as one of the entry requirements for the National Merit Scholarship Program . Students who want to take this assessment should complete the registration form that was sent to student emails on Thursday, July 21. Registration must occur by August 12, 2022 (Friday). Please continue to monitor school communication for updates on PSAT registration and dates.

Parking Passes: Passes for SENIORS ONLY will be made available on 8/10 and 8/11. Passes are \$45.00 and will be sold to ALL students starting on 8/12. Information about seniors painting parking spots will be sent to seniors separately. The process for purchasing parking passes will be on the FamilyID platform again this year. An account will need to be created if you do not already have one (This is what is used for athletics). A link to the application will be on the CATA website beginning on Wednesday, 8/10 at 8:00 am. Parking passes MAY NOT be purchased by any student who has outstanding fees. Students must have current car registration, proof of insurance, and drivers license. After completion of the application, CATA will review your submission. The student will then receive a link to pay for the pass once the application has been approved via student UCPS email. The PTSO will be sponsoring a Senior Parking Space Paint Party on Friday, August 26, for all Seniors. Pass holders will get an extra COOL treat. More details to follow.

Student Schedules: Schedules will be distributed by UCPS email for 10th-12th grade students on August 19. Freshmen will receive a copy of their schedule at orientation on August 22. There is detailed information about schedules on page 3

Schedule Corrections: Students will fill out the appropriate online form for a schedule change in August once it is released by guidance. Please follow our procedures for schedules on page 3.

New to UCPS Student Orientation: New to UCPS orientation will be at 10am on August 22. This is for students who have not attended a UCPS school. Students will meet in the media center where they will work with STUCO members and receive their Chromebook and login information. Once the event is over, these students will join the general freshmen orientation in the auditorium from 11am-1pm. New to CATA parents may choose to drop in to the gym at 11:00 to meet our PTSO parents and some staff. PTSO parents and staff will be available to answer questions and discuss both the high school and academy studies with you.

Freshmen Orientation: Students who are not new to UCPS will arrive at 11am and report directly to the auditorium. This event will end at 1pm.

Student Schedules/Schedule Corrections

Counselors will be diligently working on schedules during July and August. Freshmen and new 10th graders will receive a copy of their schedule at orientation on August 22nd. All students in 9th-12th grade will be able to access their schedules in PowerSchool starting on August 19.

Students will either receive the classes they selected during registration last Spring or students will see "Please See Counselor" in their schedule. We will not randomly give 10th-12th grade students classes they did not register for; therefore, we enter "Please See Counselor" as a placeholder in the event a class did not make or there is a conflict that needs to be discussed with the student. If a student has "Please See Counselor" in their schedule, they will have the opportunity to meet with their counselor in-person on August 24th and August 25th from 12:00pm – 3:30pm. Counselors will see students on a first come first served basis.

If a student does not have "Please See Counselor" in their schedule then the student received the courses they selected during registration in the Spring. Students who do not have "Please See Counselor" in their schedule but would like to request a correction to their schedule for a valid specified reason will have the opportunity to do so during the Schedule Correction process.

The **Schedule Correction** form will be open from **August 23 to September 2.** More information on this process is forthcoming.

We ask that you please respect the process and not email the School Counselors to inquire about schedule changes throughout the summer as school counselors do not work full time in the summer. They look forward to filling schedule holes in August or responding to requests during the first five days of the semester. Please note that email requests for schedule changes will not be accepted. All schedule correction requests must be entered into the schedule correction form that will be open the first five days of school.

Attention Class of 2023 students! You can now book your senior picture session through Cady. Go

to https://home.cady.com/welcome/

- 1. Click on Book Seniors.
- 2. Read the step information and then scroll to the bottom and click on Book Now.
- 3. Search for Central Academy of Technology & Arts, click on our name, and click select.
- 4. You will have to select a second scene. Timeless is one that is part of a basic sitting fee. Scroll down and hit continue.
- 5. If you only want a basic session, then scroll to the bottom of the page and select Simple Session for \$29.00.
- 6. Confirm your choice, scroll down and click on Continue.
- 7. You can add extras if you wish, but if you're not interested, just move past this page. Uncheck retouching unless you are interested in paying for that.
- 8. Select your location. You can go to the Cady Studios on Crownpoint Executive Drive or book a session on the school picture day. At the school session, there will only be the option of a formal picture, cap and gown, and one basic scene. There are more options at the studio.
- 9. You are welcome to get your senior pictures taken by someone else, but for the yearbook, everyone must be photographed by Cady. There will be a "yearbook only" shoot right before the photo deadline, but if you choose to come to that session you will not receive any proofs or be able to purchase any pictures.
- 10. You will receive a portfolio of pictures in the mail and you can choose to buy some or just return the whole portfolio using the postage-paid label included in your mailing.

Information for New CATA Families

- School day hours: 9:05-3:45 (Class starts at 9:05, students should all **arrive by 8:55** when the first bell rings to move to class.) If you are dropping your student off by car, you should arrive between 8:40—8:55 to ensure that your child can get to class on time.
- Lunches are determined by the 3rd block teacher. We will inform students of their lunch time on the first day of school.
- Upon arrival on the first day of school, all students will report to Advisory first. Advisory assignments will be posted at the front of the school.
- Set uniforms are not required for PE classes, but a dress code
 is strictly enforced. This will be discussed during the first day
 of class. In PE, sneakers, athletic shorts, and t-shirt are required every day.
- Lockers are not required, but you may rent a locker for \$5.00. These can be rented in the front office. **PE Lockers are required**. Your PE teacher will provide information. NO students may leave their belongings out in the PE locker room—ALL belongings must be secured with a school-issued lock. Students will be charged for missing locks.
- Supply lists will be posted on Teacher's Public Canvas pages on Thursday 8/25.
- Attendance is taken during each class, and it is vital that you are present at school every day for every class. If you must make doctor appointments during the school day, be sure to do so at different times of the day so you do not miss too many days in one class.
- Attendance matters for participation in extracurricular activities, credit for courses, and affects eligibility for sports. <u>Students too sick to come to school may not be on school grounds for extracurricular events that day.</u> Please see the NEW UCPS policy and CATA guidelines regarding absences. All absence notes need to be emailed to <u>Mr. William Smith</u>.
- Every teacher will have a web page (on Canvas) for students and parents to access with course information.
- All students will receive a student login/password to the Parent Portal so that they can see their grades. This will become active on Monday, September 12th.
- Students are expected to check their school email account daily as both teachers and administration use this to communicate with students.
- Please take the time to read or browse the Cougar Chronicle each week. All important school information is in this document.
