

Registration for Spring 2020 courses at SPCC will begin in October.

Current CCP students (students enrolled in Fall 2019 CCP courses) should complete the course request form on the following dates: October 7th – October 18th.

New and returning CCP students (students NOT enrolled in Fall 2019 CCP courses) should complete the course request form on the following dates: October 21st – November 1st.

November 4th – 8th will act as an open window for any student who has not previously completed the Google form.

IMPORTANT!!

By completing this form, you are listing the courses you are interested in taking during the Spring semester. This form DOES NOT guarantee entrance into a course. BEFORE completing this form, you should have met with your counselor AND career coach to discuss your pathway and course choices.

You will need to meet with both parties (school counselors AND career coaches) before Spring enrollment can be finalized.

Parking Passes

- ALL past due student fees must be paid before you are permitted to purchase a parking pass—this includes the 2016-2017 AND 2017-2018 technology fees, media center fees, cafeteria, and any fees owed to CATA.
- ALL Students, MUST print and bring ALL required documents with you along with the cash (exact amount) or check for \$40 made payable to Central Academy of Technology & Arts. Any incomplete application packets will delay the process and you canNOT reserve your parking spot until all documents and check are turned in. Please make sure to have your parent sign the registration forms. They are available on the CATA website under "Students". Click here for the link.
- All remaining sports will be sold in number order.
- If you pay with cash, you MUST have exact change.

Parking passes are not guaranteed available throughout the school year. Once we sell out we will start a waiting list. Students obtaining their license during the school year are not guaranteed a spot, and may have to wait until the following year to drive. We will have a waitlist for those students bringing in all appropriate documentation.


