





UNCC Mini Civil Engineering Conference Results

For the third straight year, CATA and UCPS is making a name for ourselves!!!! We have had the tradition of winning half of all of the awards presented in the competition with the top 3 places awarded in each category. This year is no exception! All (6) of the certificates earned today are hanging on the wall in Mr. Recher's classroom, along with awards from previous years. We have won a total of 24 awards in the (3) years.





For the transportation event, students are challenged to use determine various forms of transportation to find the most economical means to transport passengers across Charlotte. This is using skills learned in Math, engineering, and even English (word problems).

For the Geotechnical, students are challenged to design an earthen structure to withhold weight. They are given a 5 sided box (no top), challenged to fill the box with dry compacted sand and limited office supplies that not only support its own weight when a side of the box is

removed, but challenged to see how much weight can be added on top before the side collapses. The winning team's design and construction held over 350 pounds.

For the Environmental event, students are challenged to take a water mixture that simulates wastewater and design a filter to remove particles and odor from the water. This is directly using skills students learn in environmental science, physics and math. Student designs are judged on the amount of water that passes through their filter, the clarity of the water and the amount of time it takes. This project is almost the same challenge that is the Engineering Design and Development class the students will take their senior year.

All of the events are timed, promote team work and collaboration, and efficiency – corner stones of the engineering industry. The students deserve a huge shout out for their hard work and being able to bring together the combined learning from all of their classes at CATA.

Parking Passes – We are very limited in space at this time

- ALL past due student fees must be paid before you are permitted to purchase a
 parking pass—this includes the 2016-2017 AND 2017-2018 technology fees, media

- ALL Students, MUST print and bring ALL required documents with you along with the cash (exact amount) or check for \$40 made payable to Central Academy of Technology & Arts. Any incomplete application packets will delay the process and you canNOT reserve your parking spot until all documents and check are turned in. Please make sure to have your parent sign the registration forms. They are available on the CATA website under "Students". Click here for the link.
- All remaining sports will be sold in number order.
- If you pay with cash, you MUST have exact change.

Parking passes are not guaranteed available throughout the school year. Once we sell out we will start a **waiting list**. Students obtaining their license during the school year are not guaranteed a spot, and may have to wait until the following year to drive. We will have a waitlist for those students bringing in all appropriate documentation.

Attendance:

Attendance Policy: Students are not to miss more than 7 class periods per course whether the absences are excused or unexcused. Please help us improve student attendance. Please be aware of our attendance policy by clicking here

Reminder about early dismissals and absences: Parents, this is a reminder to send your student to school with a handwritten parent note when you need them to leave school for any reason before the end of the day. The notes must be turned in to the office before school so the student can receive an early dismissal pass and be responsible for their own dismissal time. In addition, doctor and dental appointments can only be considered for excusal if we are given a note from the doctor or dental office. Parent notes cannot excuse doctor appointments. All parent notes for student absences must be submitted to the front office within ten days of a student absence with a valid reason. We will not excuse absences for parent notes turned in after ten days. In addition, not all parent notes may be approved for excused absences.
