First of all, allow me to say on behalf of the CATA family (Teachers, Counselors, Administrators and Support Staff), that you are greatly missed! This week, I had a video conference meeting with 63 members of our CATA staff who are all working to stay well but who truly miss you and one another. UCPS is working to have a tiered approach in our work and that is PHASE 1 and Phase 2- March 17- March 30 which allows our students, families, and staff the time to focus on our physical and emotional well-being and a time to prepare for the possibilities that may lie ahead. Testing Updates:

• The March 25th SAT has been postponed and the new date is TBA.

• The May 2nd SAT has been canceled. Any student that has signed up for this SAT will get a refund from the College Board.. The June 6th SAT is still scheduled at this time.

Online Class Information:

• Students enrolled in NC Virtual Public School (NCVPS) or South Piedmont Community College (SPCC) classes are expected to continue working during this time. Please contact your professor with questions and concerns. Students enrolled in Union County Virtual (UCV) and APEX courses work has been suspended through March 30.

Registration Information:

• As of now, the CATA Registration Timeline is on hold. Please continue to check your school email for updates and this process. Your school counselors are working on creating a new registration timeline. If you have any questions please ask your school counselor.

• If you are currently enrolled in SPCC classes and plan to take classes again next year (this is for any junior) please make sure you have checked your SPCC email for the most updated registration information from Ms. Moody on how to register online by March 30.

• Students interested in taking a class next year at SPCC but who are not currently taking classes at SPCC please make sure to apply to SPCC as soon as you can by going to SPCC.edu and click Apply Online. Registration for new students is not scheduled until April 20.

Parking Passes- We are very limited in space at this time

• ALL past due student fees must be paid before you are permitted to purchase a parking pass—this includes the 2016-2017 AND 2017-2018 technology fees, media center fees, cafeteria, and any fees owed to CATA.



- ALL Students, MUST print and bring ALL required documents with you along with the cash (exact amount) or check for \$40 made payable to Central Academy of Technology & Arts. Any incomplete application packets will delay the process and you can-NOT reserve your parking spot until all documents and check are turned in. Please make sure to have your parent sign the registration forms. They are available on the CATA website under "Students". Click here for the link.
- All remaining sports will be sold in number order.
- If you pay with cash, you MUST have exact change.

Parking passes are not guaranteed available throughout the school year. Once we sell out we will start a **waiting list**. Students obtaining their license during the school year are not guaranteed a spot, and may have to wait until the following year to drive. We will have a waitlist for those students bringing in all appropriate documentation.


Reminder about early dismissals and absences: Parents, this is a reminder to send your student to school with a handwritten parent note when you need them to leave school for any reason before the end of the day. The notes must be turned in to the office before school so the student can receive an early dismissal pass and be responsible for their own dismissal time. In addition, doctor and dental appointments can only be considered for excusal if we are given a note from the doctor or dental office. Parent notes cannot excuse doctor appointments. All parent notes for student absences must be submitted to the front office within **ten** days of a student absence with a valid reason. We will not excuse absences for parent notes turned in after ten days. In addition, not all parent notes may be approved for excused absences.


