

Student Life

Congratulations CATA Students:

Medical Sciences students participated in the state HOSA Leadership Conference this past week in the area of Biomedical Debate. This was our first HOSA competition in several years and our students Vanika Mehta, Palak Desai, Harshini Janapaty, Aminata Diagne, Jana McManus, Grant Lindenberg, Charvi Kavadekar, and Lasya Kandukuri represented CATA! Thank you to Ms. Turner and Ms. Black for helping prepare our students.

Pre-Engineering Project: One of the machining projects assigned for our Advanced Studies/Metals course is a machinist's hammer. It requires milling, turning, threading, tapping, knurling, drilling...just about all the fundamental machining processes. A few of the students have reached completion. Attached is a picture of one. As you can see, the handle is knurled. The hammer faces are brass on one side and acetyl on the other. The hammer body and handle are 6061-T6 aluminum. What always impresses the teacher is to realize that in January, this student didn't even know what an engine lathe was.

Pre-Engineering and Transportation Collaboration: Our Advanced Studies Engineering students helped our Transportation Academy Students by building an adapter plate to connect an electric motor to a transmission for an electric car project. Teamwork between two academies.

LifeSmarts National Competition: Christopher Walker, George Kappas, Avery Pardue and Emily O'Connor participated in the LifeSmarts National Championship. They completed the online state qualifying competition and the national qualifier, and did well enough to compete in the 2021 national championship online. They placed 2nd out of 33 in two rounds of a virtual national competition with other high schools and competed in the top 4 semi-finals and finished in second place. They each won \$1000 in scholarship money and \$50 Amazon gift cards! Lifesmarts provides realworld education for students who learn about core consumer topics and develop critical thinking skills. Participants focus on five key topic areas: consumer rights and responsibilities, the environment, health and safety, personal finance, and technology.

AP Exams

AP TESTING 2021

You should bring the following items to the exam room:

- Several sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers) for completing multiple-choice answer sheets
- Pens with black or dark blue ink for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response
 questions in most exams
- Up to two calculators with the necessary capabilities if you are taking an AP Biology, Calculus, Environmental Science, Physics, or Stats Exam
- A ruler or straightedge for AP Physics exams

You should not bring the following to the exam room:

- Electronic devices, such as: cell phones, digital cameras, personal digital assistants (PDAs), BlackBerry, smart phones, laptops, Bluetooth-enabled devices, MP3 players, iPods, e-mail/messaging devices, camera/photographic equipment, devices that can access the internet, or any other electronic or communication devices
- Books, compasses, mechanical pencils, colored pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, protractors, or notes
- Rulers and straightedges (unless you are taking an AP Physics exam)
- Scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets)
- Computers or calculators (except as noted above)
- Reference guides, keyboard maps, or other typing instructions
- Watches that beep or have an alarm, or smartwatches
- Portable listening or recording devices (even with headphones)
- Scissors, pocket knife, or other sharp implements
- Clothing with subject-related information
- Food or drink (Unless this has been preapproved as an accommodation by the College Board Services for Students with Disabilities office prior to the test date)

Reminders:

You are required to arrive no later than 10 minutes prior to your exam: 7:50 for the morning administration and 11:50 for the afternoon administration. <u>Please DO NOT park at the Professional Development Center (PDC)</u>. Students <u>may</u> <u>not</u> be dismissed until an exam has officially ended; do not ask to leave early if you finish before the end of the exam. If you play a sport or have a job, it is your responsibility to inform your coach or employer of your AP Exam obligation, and arrangements should be made accordingly. Please note that if you ride the bus, you will need to make alternate travel arrangements as morning exams begin before CATA starts at 9:05 a.m. and afternoon exams may end after 3:45 p.m.

English Literature and US History exams will be given digitally at your home. You must be logged into the testing system prior to 12:00 noon or the exam will not be loaded onto your Chromebook. You must use your Chromebook to take these two exams. The software will be loaded onto your Chromebook.

Get a good night's rest before your exam, and eat a nutritious breakfast/brunch. You are allowed to bring a snack and beverage for your 10-minute break. However, food and drink are prohibited in the exam room. It is advisable to bring a sweater or jacket, in case the room temperature is below your comfort level – it is normally very cold at the PDC!!!

You are required to abide by the policies of both the College Board and CATA during the exam period. Any misconduct will be reported and could jeopardize your AP Exam score.

AP Scores will be available online in July. You will access your scores via your College Board account. Check the score release schedule, available on the student AP scores website in May.







<u>Attendance</u> will be taken for student participation on their assigned day at school and virtually each day in Power School. School is in session and students are expected to be in class or logged into a class session at the appropriate time each day unless otherwise stated. Students on Plan A will be counted absent if they are not in attendance on their assigned day.

<u>Attendance and Absence Notes:</u> Absence notes must be **emailed** and/or scanned to <u>Mr. William Smith</u> our data manager upon the student's return to school in order for the absence to be considered excused. Absences will be coded unexcused in PowerSchool until an email excuse is received. Please allow 24 hours for excusal notes to be coded in PowerSchool. Students may fail if they have 8 or more unexcused absences per class. Attendance is taken each class period. Students will have a chance to recover some unexcused absences.

Bus Info: Parents should email <u>Ms. Tweed</u> if they need bus transportation. Bus riders and parents should sign up for the **Here Comes the Bus App.** This app allows you to view the real-time location of your child's school bus on your smartphone, tablet or computer. Be sure that your child is a their bus stop at least **20 minutes** before the scheduled arrival time. <u>Bus App Letter English</u> <u>Bus App Letter Spanish</u>

Parking Passes One cannot drive and park at the school if they have not purchased a parking pass. Parking in any lot other than the student parking lot is not permitted. The process for purchasing parking pass is on FamilyID this year, an account will need to be created if you do not already have one. <u>Click here for FamilyID</u>. Parking passes MAY NOT be purchased by any student who has outstanding fees. After completion of the application, CATA will review your submission. The student will then receive a link to pay for the pass once the application has been approved via student UCPS email. Parking passes are \$25 starting 2/25/21 for the rest of the school year. The following guidelines will be in place for Plan A in-person instruction:

- Students must always wear a mask (except while eating or taking a short, permitted mask break)
- Visitors are **not** permitted on campus without an appointment.
- In Plan A there will be minimal social distancing (3 feet)
- Contact tracing will continue with direct Blackboard communication to our school families to note that required quarantine could occur for an individual, group, or school.
- If students are not in class, then they will be counted absent, unless sick or on quarantine. Notes must be sent to our data manager Mr. <u>William Smith</u>

The following guidelines will be in place for Plan D remote instruction:

- Students are expected to participate in online instructional activities each day for and minimum amount of time per subject/course. Approximately 90 minutes per subject. Students are expected to follow a daily schedule and attendance will be taken.
- Students must have access to a computer and high-speed internet. Students are to contact the school if they need assistance. It is expected that your camera and microphone be in working order at all times. Students can apply to receive a hot spot for access to high-speed internet.
- Students are expected to have a designated space for instruction that is conducive to learning and free of distractions.
- Students are expected to participate in online instruction and interact with both the teacher and each other during interactive sessions.
- Students are expected to turn in assignments on or before their due dates.
- Students are expected to complete assignments, tests, and quizzes independently and without the use of unapproved support.
- Each teacher will set expectations about camera use for class and students must follow all UCPS rules while engaged in an online platform with their class.
