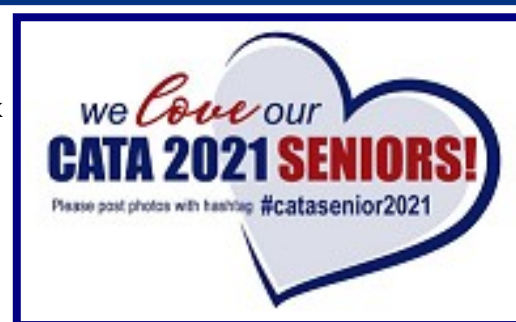

**Change Canvas Display for Students:** Many students are in "List View," which only shows classes that have a due date on assignments for the day, therefore, students think there is nothing to do in some classes and are not getting credit for assignments. All students are asked to change this setting to "Card View" so they will see all four classes daily and are forced to go into each class for daily work. [Click here](#) for directions on how to make the change.

**Spring 2020 COVID (Numerical Grade/PC19) Grade Correction Form**: All grades for the 19-20 school are stored in PowerSchool. **STUDENTS**, please login into Power School and review your final grades from Spring 2020. To do this click Grade History - click 19.20 school year - then review your A2 final grades. By default, the grade choice impacting GPA in a positive manner was entered. Students, if a grade different than the one finalized in Power School is preferred, [click here to request a change](#). You only need to fill out this form if you prefer a different grade option than what is showing. If you choose numeric average, you are choosing the higher of T4 or T4/T5 average as your final grade. The final day to process this request is Weds., **9/30 at 5:00 pm**. Please let your assigned School Counselor know if you have any questions.

**11th graders that are eligible for the PSAT** this year received an email directly from Ms. Lawson on Tuesday, August 25th. The PSAT will be given to the selected 11th grade students on **Wednesday, 10/14** beginning at 9:00 am. To be eligible to take the PSAT this year you must have earned within the 90th percentile on the PSAT your 10th grade year (score of 1170). **No 10th graders will be taking the PSAT this school year**. **Attendance** will be taken for student participation on their assigned day at school and virtually each day in Power School.

School is in session and students are expected to be in class or logged into a class session at the appropriate time each day unless otherwise stated.

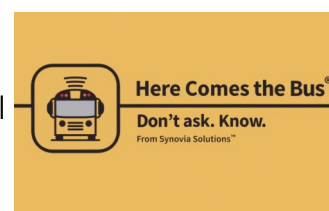


**Parking Passes** One cannot drive and park at the school if they have not purchased a parking pass. Parking in any lot other than the student parking lot is not permitted. The process for purchasing parking pass is on FamilyID this year, an account will need to be created if you do not already have one. [Click here for FamilyID](#). Parking passes MAY NOT be purchased by any student who has outstanding fees. After completion of the application, CATA will review your submission. The student will then receive a link to pay for the pass once the application has been approved via student UCPS email. Parking passes are \$45. **Bus Info:** Parents should email [Ms. Tweed](#) if they need bus transportation. Bus riders

and parents should sign up for the **Here Comes the Bus App**. This app allows you to view the real-time location of your child's school bus on your smartphone, tablet or computer. ### **Attendance and Absence Notes:**

Absence notes must be **emailed** and/or scanned to [Mr. William Smith](#) our data manager upon the student's return to school in order for the absence to be considered excused. Absences will be coded unexcused in PowerSchool until an email excuse is received. Please allow 24 hours for excusal notes to be coded in PowerSchool. Students may fail if they have 8 or more unexcused absences per class. Attendance is taken each class period. Students will have a chance to recover some unexcused absences.

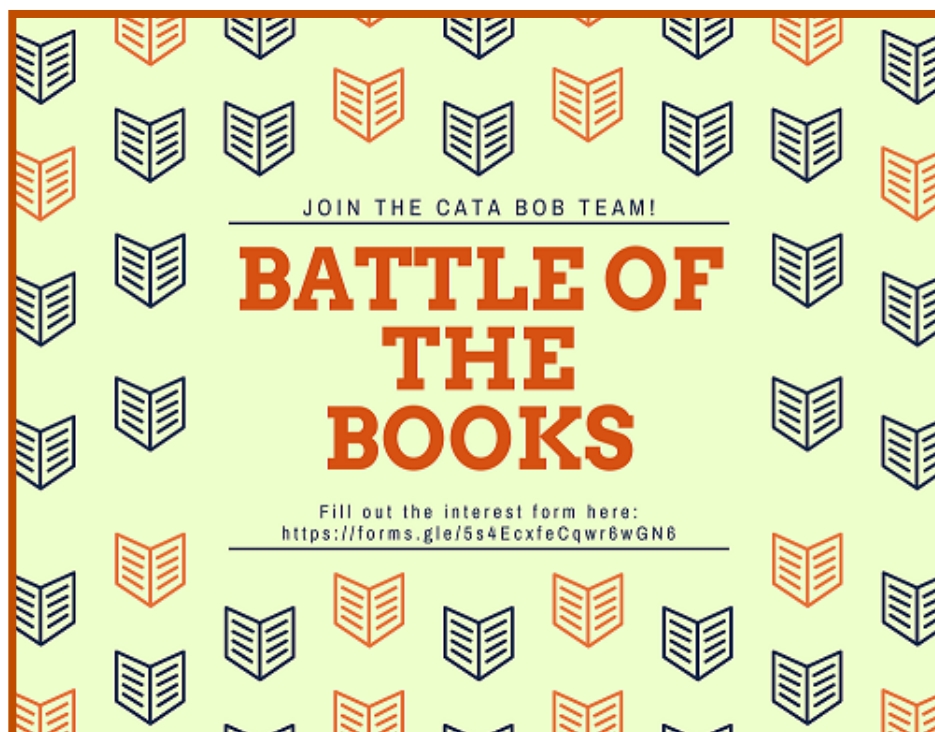

Each teacher will answer health screening questions and have their temperature taken each day.

Each student must answer a series of health questions and have their temperature taken each day.

If your child is sick or exhibiting the following symptoms then please do not send them to school.

1. Fever of 100.4 or above
2. New cough
3. New trouble breathing, shortness of breath or severe wheezing
4. New Chills
5. New Muscle Aches
6. Sore Throat
7. Diarrhea
8. New loss of smell, taste, or change in taste
9. Have been within 6 feet of a person with a lab confirmed case of the current novel virus for at least fifteen minutes, or had direct contact with their mucus or saliva, in the past 14 days
10. These protocols may also call for additional measures to be put in place based on future guidelines.

Please do not come to school if you are awaiting a test result for the current novel virus or are living with someone who has the virus even if you have tested negative. Learn remotely until your family member is cleared.

We will have a separate nurses station for students who exhibit symptoms at school.
