


Dear CATA Family,

Friday is make up exam day for those that missed an exam this week. <u>Click HERE</u> for exam information.


- 1. All EOC Exams must be taken on campus (Biology, English II, Math I, and Math III)
- 2. **CTE Exams taken on Campus that cannot be exempted:** Foods 1, Apparel 1, Health Science 1, Automotive Service 1, Collision Repair Fundamentals, Career Management, and Principles of Business.
- 3. **CTE Exams that cannot be exempted taken at Home via Canvas:** Robotics Engineering 1 Honors, Audio Engineering Technology II Honors, Electronics DC and Automotive Serv. Suspension Chassis Elect. LCO
- 4. All teacher made exams are taken at home on Canvas.
- 5. Make-Up Exams: Friday, January 14, 9:05-1:05: Only students taking make up exams are expected to come to school. Students taking teacher made exams or required at home CTE Exams should take their exams on Canvas during the exam time window. Students taking EOC and CTE Exams they are required to take at the school must come to school to make up exam.

Items to Remember

Attendance and Absence Notes: Absence notes must be emailed and/or scanned to Mr. William Smith our data manager upon the student's return to school in order for the absence to be considered excused. Absences will be coded unexcused in PowerSchool until an email excuse is received. Please allow 24 hours for



excusal notes to be coded in PowerSchool. Students may fail if they have 8 or more unexcused absences per class. Attendance is taken each class period. Students will have a chance to recover up to three unexcused absences per class. Parents will receive notification upon the 3rd, 6th, and 8th unexcused absence.

Parking Passes— are now being sold on a first come first served basis. After we run out of spots, then students will be put on a waiting list. The process for purchasing parking passes will be on the online platform "FamilyID" An account has to be created if you do not already have one. Parking passes MAY NOT be purchased by any student who



owes outstanding fees. After completion of the application, CATA will review your submission. The student will then receive a spot number and a link to pay for the pass once the application has been approved via the email provided in the registration form. Passes are \$45. Bus Transportation: Parents should email Ms. Tweed if they need bus transportation. Bus rid-



ers and parents should sign up for the Here Comes the Bus App. This app allows you to view the real-time location of your child's school bus on your smartphone, tablet or computer. Early Dismissal: If a student driver needs to be dismissed early from school, a parent note must be emailed to Mr. William Smith, our data manager prior to the start of the school day in order



for the student to receive an early dismissal pass. The emailed parent note must contain the date, student's full name, the time that the student needs to be dismissed from school and the parent's phone number. Any student being picked up early from school by someone other than a parent, must follow the same protocol stated above while giving permission for someone else to pick up the student. Email the Mr. William Smith. In the event that a parent does not email a note, the parent must call the school to speak to someone in the front office.
