-Senior Returns and Owed Fees: All seniors not taking exams should have returned their Chromebooks and Chargers on Thursday, May, 26 at lunch. Seniors should return all books,

calculators, uniforms, and any other school owned items to their teachers, coaches, or appropriate CATA staff this week. Exam Information:

1) Exam Exemption Policy: For TEACHER MADE EXAMS ONLY. Each teacher will notify exempt students. High

School students will not be required to take a teacher-made final exam in a course in the following situations:

- The student has an average of 90 or above the week prior to the administration of the exam and has no more than 2 unexcused absences in the class; or
- The student has an average of 80 or above the week prior to the administration of the exam and has no more than 1 unexcused absence in the class
- Teacher made tests are defined as tests designed and graded by a UCPS teacher of record for the purpose of assigning an exam grade to a student. Exam exemptions only apply to teacher made tests and are not available in courses which require the administration of an End of Course or state mandated final exams. Students enrolled in AP courses will still be required to take the AP exam. Students are expected to take all other assessments given at the school.
- 2) EOC Exams cannot be exempted: (Biology, English II, Math I, and Math III) taken on campus
- 3) **CTE Exams cannot be exempted:** Apparel I, Apparel II, Network Engineering Technology III, Audio Engineering Technology I, Electronics AC, Automotive Service Engine Drivetrain LCO, Automotive Service Fundamentals, Automotive Service II, Introduction to Cyber Security, Robotics I, Health Science I
- 4) All teacher made exams are taken ON CAMPUS
- 5) Only teacher made exams can be exempted and each teacher will notify the student if they are exempted from the exam the Monday before exams begin.
- 6) June 3rd is an important day for any students who have missed an exam earlier in the week due to illness. If missing the exam is due to Covid-19, the school will communicate a plan with each individual student and family. We regret that family vacation plans are not excused, and students cannot take exams early. We apologize that any requests for exceptions cannot be honored.
- 7) Dismissal: The school day ends around 1:05 PM or a little after when the exam period is over. All car drivers must go home, all students who ride cars must go home, and bus riders can have a parent come pick them up or will wait at the school until the buses arrive in a supervised designated area. We are anticipating buses arriving between 2:30 and 3:00 PM. A students does not need a note to leave school if you drive, have a parent pick you up, or ride a bus home.
- 8) Teachers will be available via email until 3:45 PM each day if students have exam or grade related questions.
- 9) Lunch will be served directly after exams for those that wish to eat lunch at school in the cafeteria.

Exam Study Tips and Information:

Be on time! Students should be in their testing locations before 9:00 a.m. They will not be admitted to exams once testing has begun. Students are encouraged to sleep well each night (8 hours), and have a healthy breakfast each morning

Create a study calendar and stick to it

Ask your teacher for a study guide and USE IT!!

Use your notebook to guide you through a review of the course

Attend all review sessions offered

Go to tutoring for extra support

Make a study group, assign each person a topic to re-teach, and discuss each topic

Have your parents ask you questions

Use diagrams, graphs, pictures, and drawings in your textbook to serve as a talking point for you to review Make flashcards on your computer or phone to practice important vocabulary words

Look at your scores from the semester and identify topics you struggled in – ask your teacher or a friend for help

Stay after school to study - let an administrator know which days your study group needs to stay and study and we will arrange for you to stay to study

Rewrite important points, the act of writing or typing helps some people remember specific information Create an acronym, or a funny saying, or song to remember specific information

Draw a quick sketch to help with definitions or concepts

Practice math problems

Type of Exams: We have three types of exams at the end of each semester – EOC, CTE State Assessment, and Teacher-Made. Teachers will address which type of exam their students will take.

Testing Window: All exam testing must be completed between May 27-June 3. This is true for ALL types of exams: EOC, CTE State Assessments, and Teacher-Made. Students may not test early, and if absent on an exam day, they must make arrangements to be at school on the make-up day in order to meet the approved testing window timeframe.

Score Results: All high school exams count 25% of a student's grade for the semester. Please emphasize this point to students so that they study.

Exam review: All teachers are expected to help students with review during class time and to distribute a review guide on canvas to students prior to testing. Teachers will have review sessions for each class as stated in the schedule above. Students should begin organizing and reviewing material.

Academic Integrity: Please remind students of the need to prepare well for the exams and to make sure that they make ethical decisions when taking exams. The penalty for cheating of any kind is a "0" on a final exam. Students will be required to turn in cell phones during testing sessions. If they do not want to do this, they should not bring their cell phone into the school.

Graduation Day Procedures 2022

<u>Graduation:</u> Our graduation date is on Tuesday, June 7, at 8 AM, at Walter Bickett Stadium. The address is 704 Washington Street, Monroe NC 28112. We will live stream this on the Central Academy of Technology & Arts YouTube Channel. There is a link to the channel on our school website at the bottom of the home page. Rain and Weather: Unless otherwise stated we will hold our graduation at 8:00 AM. If you arrive and there is a delay, please check our social media sites for updates. Since we are at an off campus venue, then we will ask graduates and guests to wait in their cars until we give an all clear unless otherwise announced. If there is not a delay for lightning and just rain, then you may stay in the stands with an umbrella if you do not wish to go to your car. It is strongly suggested you bring a towel to wipe down seats or stadium seat cushions.

<u>Graduation Day Procedures:</u> We will use the home side permanent stands, temporary bleachers, and seats on the field. No guests or students will be allowed in the Walter Bickett Parking area without the parking passes and in the gates without tickets. Please make sure all items and fees are cleared the week before graduation. If you have questions, please contact our bookkeeper, Ms. Deana Huneycutt. <u>Deana.huneycutt@ucps.k12.nc.us</u>

Entering the Stadium (You will need to refer to the attached map): There are two entrances for ticketed guests. The double swinging gate off of S Johnson Street/Washington Street is **Gate A**, and the double gates off of S Johnson Street on the home stadium side is **Gate B**. Parents or guests must present tickets and will sit on the home side or be directed to the field to sit in bleachers or chairs. Parents must sit where asked. We will begin filling in the top rows first, then come down. The bottom row will be for late arrivals. Entrance begins at 7 am and is shut down at 7:45 AM. We cannot accommodate late arrivals past 7:45.

Handicapped Parking and Seating: Handicapped parking is on South Johnson Street in front of the stadium gate. Please display handicapped stickers or let a staff member directing traffic know you need accommodations for parking and seating. (GATE B is the handicap entrance. Guests who need assistance will sit in front of the home side of the stadium on the field on the gravel track and chairs will be provided for guests to sit together. All other handicapped accommodations should be emailed to josh.wall@ucps.k12.n.us.

<u>Graduate Drop Off</u>: Graduates should be dropped off at the Washington street driveway before the double gates to line up for the Processional. An Academy teacher will be there to help line up students. Parents and Guests should then proceed to park after dropping off seniors and Enter in Gate A or B.

Diploma Packets and Programs: Our Counseling Department will hand out diploma packets to **parents** right after entry into the stadium. **Parents** must pick up diploma packets before being seated. The packets will include a diploma, programs, picture information, and transcripts (official to be mailed and unofficial).

<u>Graduate Assigned Seats</u>: Students will be sitting in Alphabetical Order by Academy (Which are in alphabetical order). There are 14 rows of 14 seats. A to N and seats numbered 1 to 14. If a student is not here, then their seat will be skipped and their name will be marked off the list to be called to walk across the stage. Student names and seat numbers will be marked on each seat. **Students will receive a card with their seat number when they pick up their Graduation Packets (with tickets and parking passes). Students will be handed another card once they arrive on graduation day while in the processional line. All students should be in their caps and gowns with comfortable shoes. Students may wear clothes for hot weather within the school dress code. Graduation Speakers will sit in row A seats 1-6 and return to assigned seat with their academy after they speak. Graduation speakers will lead the students in the processional. Students will move tassels, but are asked not to throw caps. Continued on the Next Page**

<u>Photographer</u>: The student will stop for a brief picture with the principal after they get their diploma cover. There will be an X to mark the spot. The student will take another photo as they exit the stage. Photography information will be in the Diploma Packets.

Processional and Recessional:

Processional: Students will be lined up in alphabetical order by academies along the outside gate of the Washington Street Parking lot behind the concession stand building in the Walter Bickett Education Center Parking Lot. Academy teachers will be there to line up students and give out seating assignment cards. Students will be led by staff members and Junior Marshals in a single file line, enter the gate to the inside parking lot (Where the concession stand is located), walk down the hill onto the field, behind the stage and around to their seats. Students should walk down the row until they find their seat. If you have a 1 then you will be the first person on the row facing the stage (closest to the baseball infield) and if you are seat 14, then you will be the last student on the row (closest to the home stands). To keep it simple just have your seating card, the rows and seats will be labeled and staff will assist.

Recessional: At the conclusion of the ceremony, the administration and UCPS officials will exit the stage and walk toward the gravel track on the home side. Then, staff will help rows of students to get up one row at a time to walk in a circle around the field and then exit to their cars. You will exit the row the opposite way you entered the row. Junior Marshals and staff will be there to assist. Parents must remain in their seats (or stand at their seats) and cannot come down to the gate. Parents will be dismissed at various exits after the recessional. Students are not allowed to pose for pictures at Walter Bickett Stadium after the recessional due to traffic concerns. Parents and Students may go to the CATA campus and take photos outside of the building.


Parking and Directions: You will be directed where to park. Each graduate is allowed ONE or TWO parking passes and four to eight guests. **Each family is encouraged to use only one pass if possible.** All graduates and guests should arrive in one or two cars. If you have to meet another group, then you may go to CATA's main campus at 600 Brewer Drive and meet in the student parking lot to get into one car. This is due to parking limitations at the stadium.

The parking pass must be displayed to enter the parking entrance which is off of **Washington Street**. All cars **must enter on Washington Street off of Lancaster Avenue**. A staff member and a police officer will be placed at each entry point to check for passes.

Cars will proceed around the block to park on Griffith Road until full on the right side of the road only, cars will continue to turn right and park on S. Johnson Street until full. Note the spaces next to the stadium gate are for handicapped parking and the handicapped entrance will be the gate off of S. Johnson Street onto the field close to Gate B. Please display your handicapped sticker or email josh.wall@ucps.k12.nc.us if there is a special circumstance we need to accommodate. Cars will then go into the parking lot off of S Johnson at Sunset Park, and once the lot is full cars will turn left and park on S Johnson Street on both sides. Cars will continue up South Johnson and when full, park on both sides of Bickett Street headed toward Sunset Drive. Cars will continue to come in and park on Washington Street on both sides going toward S. Johnson Street. Parking can be on both sides and in some turn spaces all the way back to Lancaster Avenue. In addition, cars may park on the roads in the cemetery. Once this parking is exhausted then cars will park in the WBES parking lots under the direction of a staff member.

Cars must follow an exit pattern: Those on Griffith Road will go straight and turn left or right on Lancaster Avenue. Those on S. Johnson parked toward Griffith Road on both sides of the street will exit by going straight and turning right on Griffith Road. Those on Washington Street on the right side will turn right on S. Johnson, go straight and turn right on Griffith Road. Those on the left side of Washington will go straight, turn left on South Johnson, then right on Bickett to exit left or right onto Sunset. Those in the WBEC parking lot will turn right on to Washington Street and may exit to the right or left on S. Johnson and follow those exit patterns.

We would like to provide you some updated information for your senior year. We ask that you review the entire letter with your family to familiarize yourselves with the information and expectations.

<u>Graduation</u>: Our graduation date is on Tuesday, June 7, at 8 AM, at Walter Bickett Stadium. The address is 704 Washington Street, Monroe NC 28112. We will live stream this on the Central Academy of Technology & Arts YouTube Channel. There is a link to the channel on our school website at the bottom of the home webpage. We will share the link closer to the date of the event. In addition, we will send senior families logistics on parking and stadium entrance about a week before the event. There is no graduation practice.

<u>Tickets and Parking Passes</u>: Each graduate is allowed 4 tickets and has a chance to request up to four more for a total of 8 tickets until May 25. Each graduate will receive one parking pass. A family with a special circumstance or using more than five tickets in need of a second parking pass may request one by emailing Dr. Wall at <u>josh.wall@ucps.k12.nc.us</u> until May 25. <u>Graduation Packets:</u> Packets will contain parking passes, cords, tickets, and graduation information (procedures and maps). Students must pick up these packets for parking passes and tickets. Students should bring any remaining items or fees to the front office. Students will not be allowed to pick up packets if they owe materials and fees to the school. Packets can be picked up on Monday, June 6, between 9-11 AM at CATA.

Name Pronunciations: All Seniors must email Dr. Josh Wall an audio clip of their legal first, middle, and last name as stated in Power School. **This is past due.** Please make an audio clip on your phone or computer and email to <u>josh.wall@ucps.k12.nc.us</u> with your first and last name in the subject line.

<u>Returning Items to CATA:</u> This includes, but is not limited to Chromebooks and chargers, calculators, textbooks, athletic uniforms, Jiffy Pass, library materials, and other school owned items. 

<u>Graduation Day Procedures:</u> We will use the home side permanent stands, temporary bleachers, and seats on the field. Graduates will sit spaced in rows in front of the stage (about 3 feet so they can be easily seen by guests in the stands). No students or parents will be allowed in the Walter Bickett Parking area without the parking passes and in the gates without tickets. A detailed document about specific graduation day procedures will go out the week of May 23.

Diploma Packets: Our Guidance Department will hand out diploma packets after students and parents enter the stadium to the parents. Parents must pick up their diploma packets before being seated. The packets will include a diploma, programs, picture information, and transcripts (official to be mailed and unofficial too).

Photographer: The student will stop on stage for a brief picture with the principal after they get their diploma cover. There will be an X to mark the spot. The student will take another photo as they exit the stage. Photography information will be in the Diploma Packets.
