

Important Graduation Information

Graduation Rehearsal: Friday, June 3rd 12:00pm

All seniors participating in Commencement are required to attend rehearsal on Friday, June 3rd at 12:00pm. The check-in table will open at 11:15am by the gym doors near the student entrance of the school. All students will proceed to their line pods in preparation for practicing the processional. Academic cords will be handed out at rehearsal check in.

Graduation: Monday, June 6th at 8:00am.

Weddington High School's Class of 2022 Commencement will be held on Monday, June 6th at 8:00am at the high school stadium. Seniors are expected to arrive and line up by 7:15am. Students may park in the student parking lot as early as 7:00am, check in at the table in the gym, and then proceed to their assigned pod for line up. We will begin the processional at 7:45am. It is extremely important that students arrive by 7:15am in order to ensure students are able to check in and be in line for the processional.

Dress code for students is business casual. Males should wear a collared shirt and females a dress, skirt, or dress pants. No flip-flops or high heels. Ladies should affix the white collar that comes with the graduation gown. Hats may NOT be decorated and cords that are not assigned from our school may not be worn.

Graduation Tickets and Parking:

Each graduating senior will have 8 tickets to the ceremony. Each student must claim their tickets from the school website and distribute a QR code to their attendees. **Tickets became available to claim beginning Monday, May 9th at 8:00am and will remain available to claim through Friday, June 3rd at**

Graduation will be livestreamed. The livestream link can be accessed by clicking <u>HERE</u>. This link is also available on social media and our webpage.

Senior Collections:

Seniors will not be allowed to walk in the graduation ceremony if their school account has not been cleared. A staff member will be available Friday as well as following graduation practice to assist students with clearing any outstanding fees. It is extremely important that all seniors ensure that they have turned in all textbooks, library materials, Chromebook and charger, and any outstanding fees that they owe.

Scholarships

We are asking all seniors to report their scholarship and merit aid AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. We want to feature all seniors for their scholarships. This includes ALL dollars earned regardless if you are attending the college or not.

SENIOR GRADUATION PICTURES

The group panoramic cap and gown photo taken in the stadium will be added to each senior's cap and gown profile in Cady. Parents can either add the panoramic onto their cap and gown order or they can purchase it a la carte for \$30 by skipping ahead to step 4 in the ordering process. Cady studio will also be taking pictures at graduation of each senior walking across the stage and holding their diploma after walking off the stage. Any student with an existing profile with CADY will receive an email with a link to their posed graduation photos 24 hours after the ceremony. Parents and students can also find their graduation profile by going to cady.com/graduation and searching by their first and last name. RISING SENIOR SUMMER PORTRAIT SESSIONS

It is now time to schedule your rising senior portraits through Cady Studios! You must have your portrait taken by Cady to be in the yearbook. Take advantage of the limited time promotion to receive a free scene when you schedule your session before the end of June. Sessions can be scheduled around your schedule when it is convenient for you. Sessions will take place at Cady Studios in Matthews at your scheduled time. Parents and students have until November 30th to schedule their portrait session. Cady Studios offers a variety of session options. The basic session includes the yearbook photo, one scene of your choice, and cap/gown photo for a \$30 sitting fee. This basic session is called



Brag Sheet - please refer to your Scoir account to complete the Brag Sheet. The Brag Sheet will serve as the foundation of college applications, admission essays, personal statements, and when preparing for interviews. Once logged into Scoir, click on the three lines in the top right-hand corner, scroll down, and select "surveys" to begin. Scoir will automatically save your work while in progress. **Do NOT hit "submit" until the entire survey is finished**.

Once submitted, the information shared will be accessible via the respective Scoir account. A completed Brag Sheet is required of any student requesting a letter of recommendation from a WHS teacher and/counselor. No brag sheet = no letter. Please see attached documents for further assistance.
