GRADUATION UPDATE



Weddington High School graduation is scheduled for Monday, June 6, 2021 at 8:00am. Graduation will be held at Weddington High School's Warrior Stadium. In addition, the graduation will be livestreamed on our school's YouTube page for public viewing.

Each graduate will be issued **8 graduation tickets**. There will not be an opportunity to request additional tickets above the 8 that we are issuing to each participating graduate. Due to the limited number of parking spaces on our campus, carpooling will be essential. Tickets will made available in May. Additional information regarding how to claim tickets in May will be shared in late April.

All seniors participating in commencement are required to attend practice on Friday, June 3rd. Specific information regarding commencement practice will be shared prior to the event.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

We have been notified by the elementary school that a number of students are parking in the elementary school parking lot. Students are not permitted to park in the elementary or middle school parking lots. Unauthorized vehicles parked at the elementary or middle schools will be towed at the owners expense. **Students are also not to park in the church parking lot across from the school or on the streets in surrounding neighborhoods.**

Students are NOT to be dropped off or picked up in the surrounding neighborhoods. All student drop-offs in the morning and pick-ups at dismissal are to be done in the car rider line. We also ask that all cars pull all the way down in the car rider line as directed by staff. This allows more students to access their rides at one time, thereby speeding up the pick-up process.


