The virus can live up to 2 hours in air space of a room after the infected person leaves the room. An infected individual is contagious for 4 days before and 4 days after developing the measles rash. Exposed individuals need to monitor themselves for symptoms for 21 days after exposure. UCHD and School Nurses will work together to identify contacts and notify parents when needed.
