High School Pathways

Spanish Immersion

These are suggested pathways and will vary based on student and school schedules, student interest, and availability of courses. As part of Career & College Promise, the Community Spanish Interpreter Program* is offered through South Piedmont Community College (SPCC). There are entrance requirements and it takes 3 semesters to complete. Tuition is covered for high school students. Students who don't finish during high school can finish the last semester of the program with SPCC after graduation, with tuition and fees paid by the student. Once students enroll in the Community Spanish Interpreter Program, they will not be allowed to take UCPS courses pass/fail.

9th Grade Registration

All students should register for Spanish III & IV for 9th grade. Students take a placement test and the AAPPL assessment in spring of 8th grade. Results will be shared with parents and counselors, and summer adjustments to student schedules will be based on the results and student/parent preferences.
