STUDENTS MUST SCORE A PROFICIENT-LEVEL 3, 4, OR 5 ON EOC EXAMS AS A UCPS GRADUATION REQUIREMENT

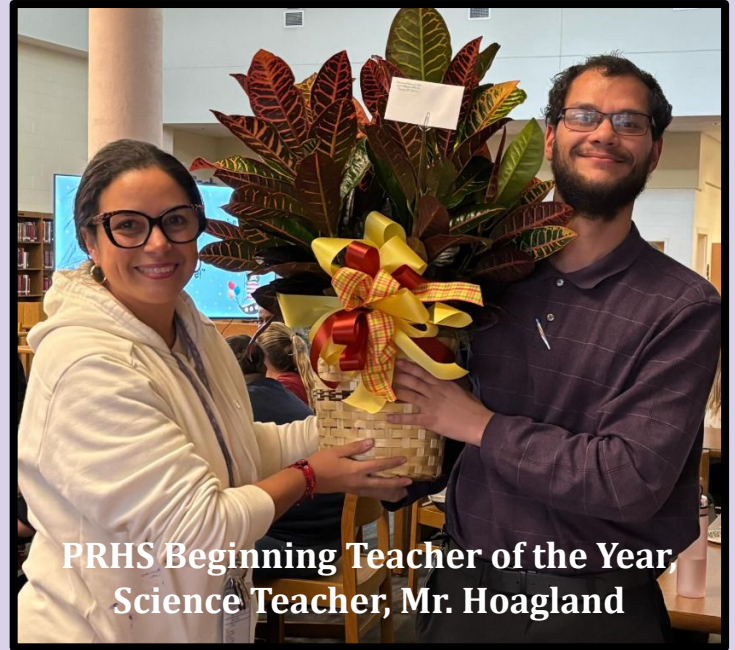
How students prepare and perform is important! Students must score at a Proficient level (Level 3, 4, or 5) on End of Course (EOC) Exams as a UCPS graduation requirement.

Students grades during the semester, along with their EOC, determine their final grade. A final grade of passing will allow students to earn HS credit for the course, however, in UCPS students must not only earn credit for the course, but must also show proficiency on End of Course Exams in Math I, Math III, Biology, & English II.

Students show proficiency by earning a score of Level 3, 4, or 5 on the exam. Students who are not proficient will have the opportunity to remediate and retake the test on two days at the end of the school year after the last day of school. If students still do not show proficiency on their second attempt of the exam, they will be prescribed additional course work to allow them to increase their understanding of the material and show mastery of the content in an alternative way the following school year.

As we continue to build a school culture of excellence - we ask all students to do their best on each assessment so that they meet the graduation requirements the first time they take the exam.

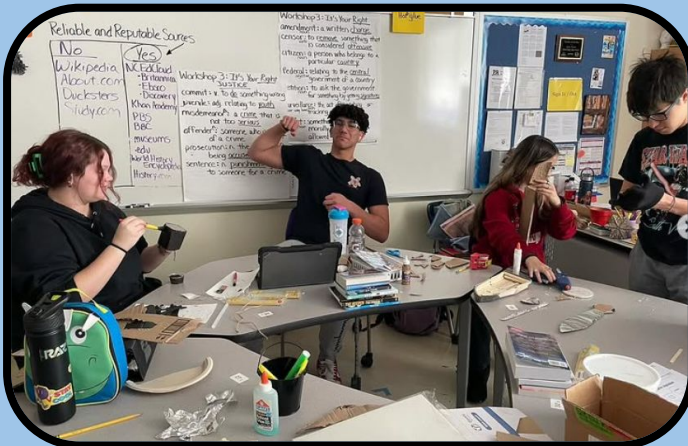

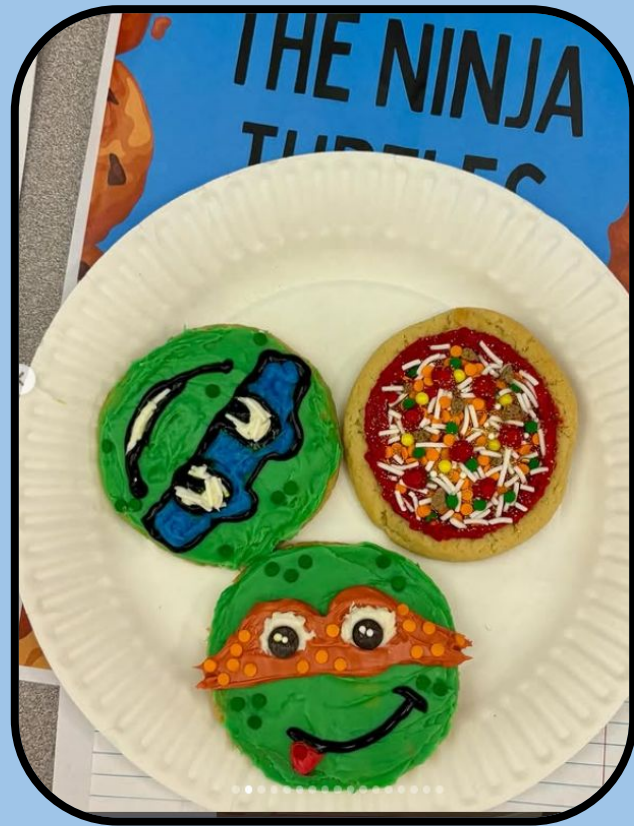

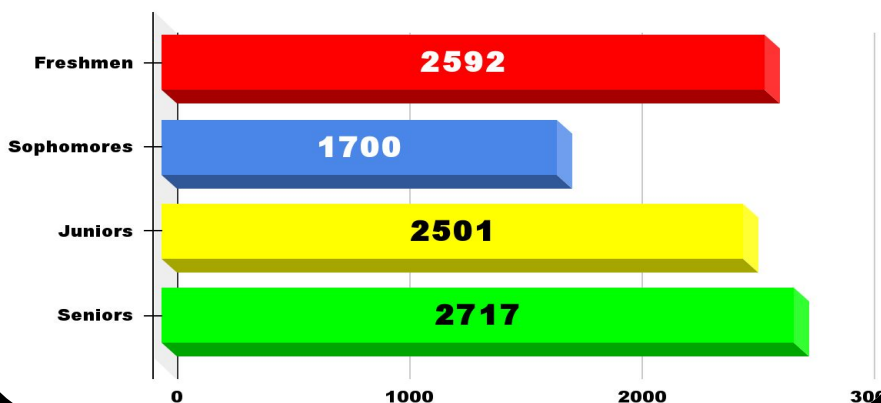

NEW PROTOCOLS
FOR UCPS EVENTS

UCPS has experienced a number of safety incidents at athletic events around the county.

For fall sports, UCPS will implement the following protocols.

- Only clear bags, no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" will be allowed in events/games. Medical and baby bags are subject to search.
- Middle and elementary students must be accompanied by an adult (21 years or older) to attend events and games.
- All ticket sales will end at the beginning of halftime or at the mid-point of an event.
- After consulting with law enforcement and district leaders, UCPS will utilize body scanners at events. The use of body scanners will begin in the fall of 2024 at football games.



Parent or guardian must create an account. The system will not accept submissions from student email accounts. PRHS will review accounts created to ensure that the email address used matches the parent email address in powerschool. For safety reasons if the email address does not match the known parent email, the account will be deleted. For reference, the school newsletter, the Pirate Press, is sent to the parent email address on file. You can also call the school to check on your email

Report Absences



Parent or guardian will submit all absences digitally via this Microsoft form.

Please Note:

- Must submit one day absence at a time.
- You cannot submit an absence before it occurs
- You must upload documentation necessary to excuse absences.
- Porter Ridge High School may only accept a maximum of 5 absences per semester excused with a parent note. After 5 days, only a doctor's note will be accepted.

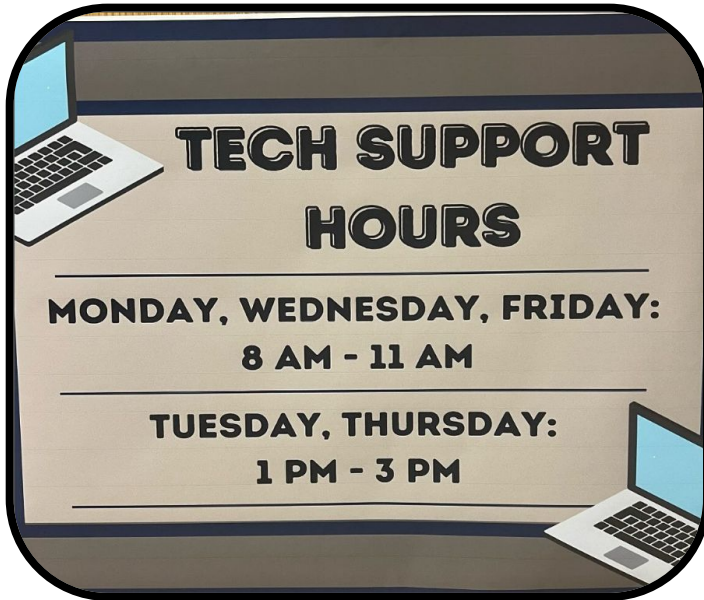

Attend Today and Achieve Tomorrow

Student attendance at school is expected and is necessary for students to make the most of their learning. Please work with us as we try to teach our students that attendance is required, just as it would be at a job in their future.

- Parents can provide notes for up to five days that a student is absent. After those days PRHS will require a doctor/medical note to excuse the absence.
- An absence will be recorded as unexcused until the note is submitted. Parent notes must be in within five days of the student's return to school.
- If a student misses 8 or more days of school in a semester, whether the absences are excused or unexcused, the student may fail the course due to attendance.
