

Exam Exemptions

High school students will not be required to take a **teacher** made final exam in a course in the following situations Students will have final notifications on 1/9:

The student has an average of 90 or above. Teacher made exams are defined as tests designed and graded by a UCPS teacher of record for the purpose of assigning an exam grade to a student.

All Students must bring their computer & charger to school each day. All exams with the exception of some teacher made exams will be administered online.

Friday, January 17 is a teacher workday, so there is no school for students UNLESS you have a make up exam! If you have a make up exam come to school at the regular time. Please see the information on the right. No transportation is provided.

Monday, January 20 is the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Holiday. There is no school!

2nd semester requests should be made at this time. All corrections must be requested on the same submission. Only one request will be allowed. Please know that classes are mostly full so very few changes will occur.

All schedules have been reviewed. We will not make changes for students who were placed in the 1st or alternative courses requested.

Requests will only be considered for the following:

- * senior is missing a required class for graduation or for college admissions
- * student has not met or is missing a prerequisite for a course for which they are enrolled * student is taking a course that he/she has passed
- * student is missing a required core course (English, Math, Science, Social Studies) in their schedule
 - * student has the same course listed twice on the schedule *student has Please See Your Counselor listed on their schedule

Please See Counselor is listed on your schedule if your counselor was not able to fill your schedule with courses you selected (including alternates).

A counselor will email you as we are able to process your request at your UCPS school email whether a correction can or cannot be made to your schedule.

Create your account

Parent or guardian must create an account. The system will not accept submissions from student email accounts. PRHS will review accounts created to ensure that the email address used matches the parent email address in powersohool. For safety reasons if the email address does not match the known parent email, the account will be deleted. For reference, the school newsletter, the Pirate Press, is sent to the parent email address on file. You can also call the school to check on your email



Report Absences

Parent or guardian will submit all absences digitally via this Microsoft form.



Please Note:

- Must submit one day absence at a time.
- You cannot submit an absence before it occurs
- You must upload documentation necessary to excuse absences.
- Porter Ridge High School may only accept a maximum of 5 absences per semester excused with a parent note. After 5 days, only a doctor's note will be accepted.









Attend Today and Achieve Tomorrow

Student attendance at school is expected and is necessary for students to make the most of their learning. Please work with us as we try to teach our students that attendance is required, just as it would be at a job in their future.

- Parents can provide notes for up to five days that a student is absent. After those days PRHS will require a doctor/medical note to excuse the absence.
- An absence will be recorded as unexcused until the note is submitted. Parent notes must be in within five days of the student's return to school.
- If a student misses 8 or more days of school in a semester, whether the absences are excused or unexcused, the student may fail the course due to attendance.
