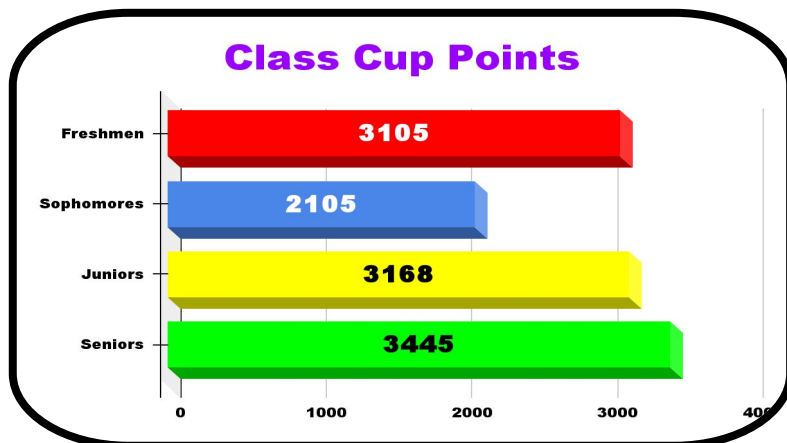

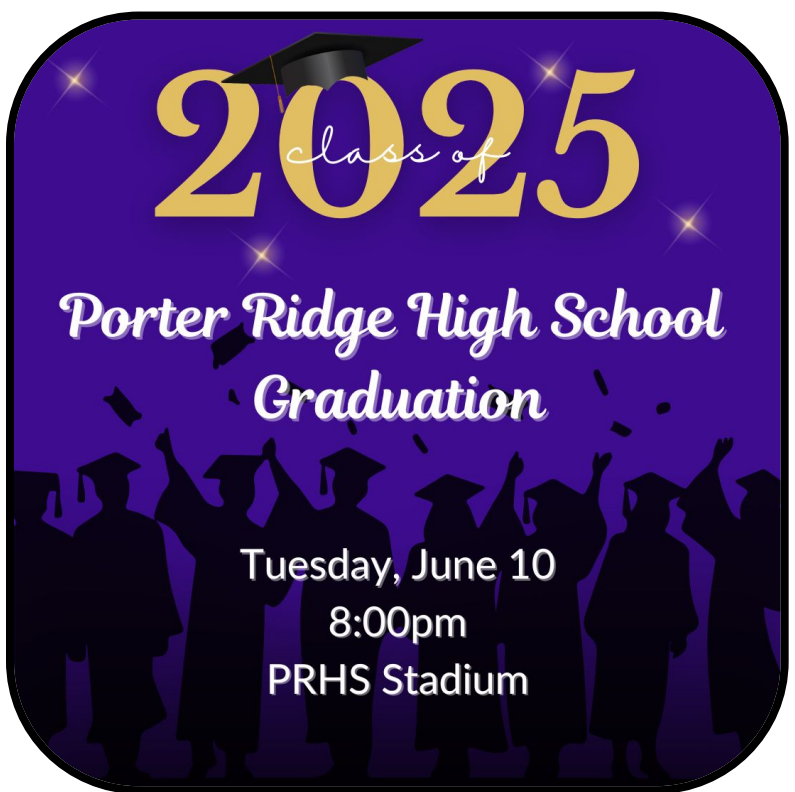

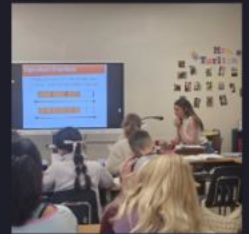

“2025-2026 Pre-Apprenticeship”

Pre-apprenticeship programs have varied program elements; however, at the core, places an individual on a pathway to employability through a RAP.

! NEW PROTOCOLS FOR UCPS EVENTS

UCPS has experienced a number of safety incidents
at athletic events around the county.

For fall sports, UCPS will implement the following protocols.

- Only clear bags, no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" will be allowed in events/games. Medical and baby bags are subject to search.
- Middle and elementary students must be accompanied by an adult (21 years or older) to attend events and games.
- All ticket sales will end at the beginning of halftime or at the mid-point of an event.
- After consulting with law enforcement and district leaders, UCPS will utilize body scanners at events. The use of body scanners will begin in the fall of 2024 at football games.

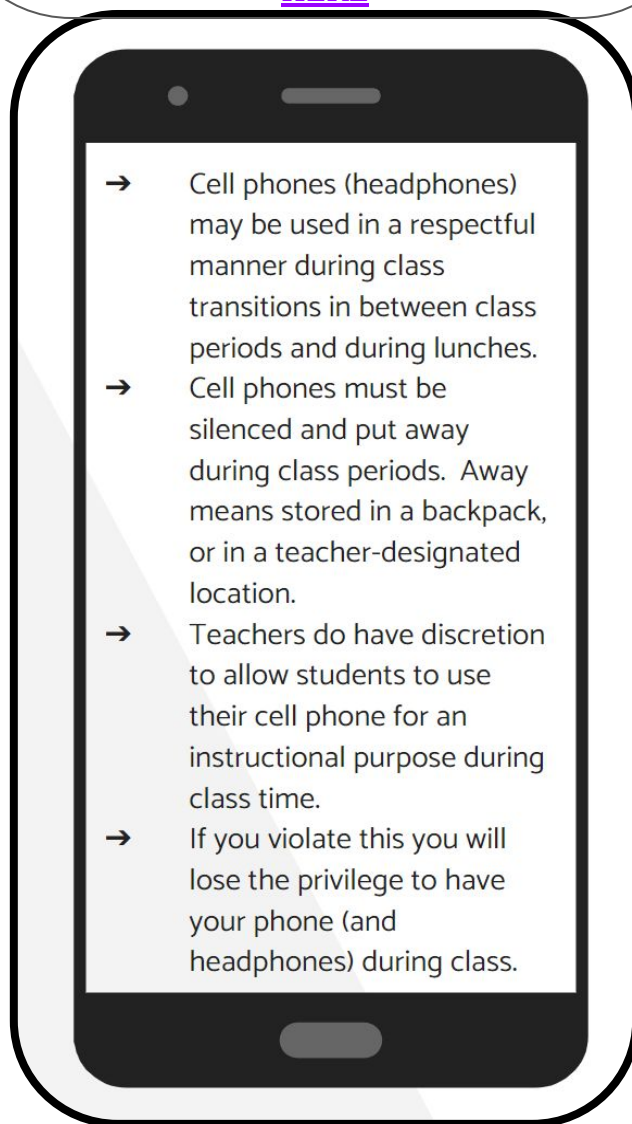

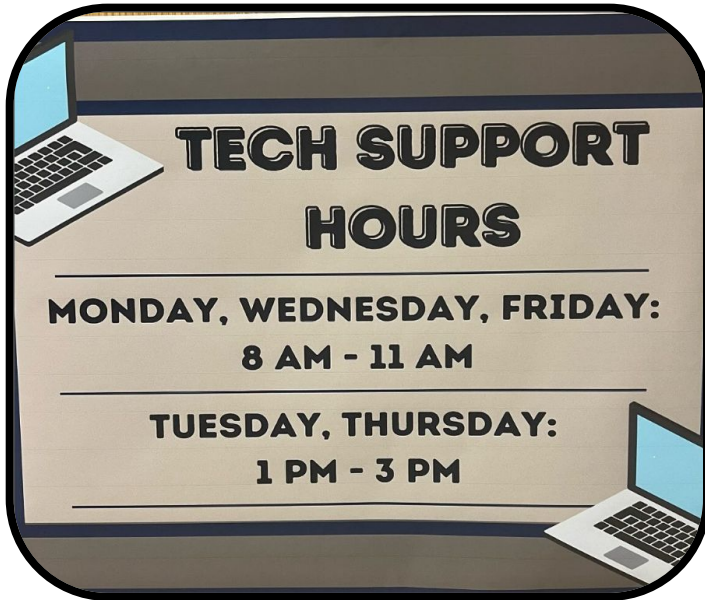
