For Students

Using Scoir with Common App™

Your school is integrating Common App with Scoir. This means you must connect your Common App account to Scoir to sync your college lists and request recommendations in Scoir.

How It Works

You'll still use Common App to complete and submit your applications, but you'll connect your Common App account to Scoir to sync your college lists. This lets your counselor see where you're applying and helps make sure the right documents get sent. If permitted by your school, you'll also use Scoir to request and assign teacher recommendations.

Some steps happen in Common App, and others in Scoir:

In Common App, you'll:	In Scoir, you'll:

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Submit your applications	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mark outcomes once you hear back

Once your accounts are connected and you've added colleges in Common App, your counselor takes it from there in Scoir. They'll prepare and send your school documents—like transcripts and school reports—to Common App. These documents are only released to colleges after you submit your application. If you request a Fee Waiver or submit an Early Decision Agreement, your counselor will also complete their part in Scoir after you finish yours in Common App.

🤔 Not sure if your school is using the Common App integration?

If you're a senior, you'll see a **Connect to Common App** button on your Scoir profile—this is a quick way to tell if your school is using the integration.

Getting Started with Scoir + Common App™

Your school is using the Common App integration in Scoir! 🌟 Once the integration is turned on, you'll see in your Profile where you can connect your Scoir and Common App accounts.

How It Works

We're not building the full Common App application experience *into* Scoir, and you'll still need to set up a Common App account to complete and submit your applications. Throughout the experience, there are certain actions you'll need to take in Common App, and others you'll complete in Scoir.

<input type="radio"/> Create an account and begin completing your My Common Application. Add your high school in the Education section (which is how Common App will recognize you as a Scoir student)	Common App
<input type="radio"/> Add at least one college to your list and sign your FERPA Release Authorization to ensure counselors can supply supporting application materials to all colleges you apply via Common App.	Common App
<input type="radio"/> Connect your Scoir and Common App accounts beginning in Scoir by going to Me > View Profile . In the Personal Details section, click Connect Common App . From there, login to Common App, and once successful, you'll be redirected back to Scoir. You'll see your connection status updated and your Common App My Colleges activity will sync with your list in Scoir.	Scoir
<input type="radio"/> For colleges you're applying via Common App, be sure to indicate a Preferred Start Term and Application Plan so that counselors can see required documents and status.	Common App
<input type="radio"/> On top of your FERPA, you'll also make Fee Waiver requests, and complete your portion of Early Decision Agreements in Common App for those colleges you're applying via Common App.	Common App
<input type="radio"/> If allowed, request teacher recommendations. You can only assign one recommendation per teacher across all of your Common App colleges. This limitation only applies to Common App schools. <i>NEW! One change you'll notice is once recommendations are complete, you'll need to assign them to colleges once completed by a teacher. To keep things easy, we recommend asking for general recommendations for Common App colleges when possible since they can be assigned to multiple colleges.</i>	Scoir
<input type="radio"/> Continue building your My Colleges lists in Scoir, indicate colleges you're applying to using other application methods, and keep it as up to date as possible! We'll also support marking colleges as Applying when Common App is the application method, but we'll limit the information provided and prompt when it's necessary to take actions in Common App.	Scoir

Career Plans

Beginning in the 2024-2025 school year, NC Senate Bill 193 requires that all students in grades 6-12 have a career plan. A student's initial career plan will be created by the end of their 6th grade year and then revised annually through 12th grade. UCPS will utilize Major Clarity as the platform for students to create their career plan. This can be accessed by students through Clever. Parents are encouraged to review their student's career plan with them each year.

 **NEW PROTOCOLS**
FOR UCPS EVENTS

UCPS has experienced a number of safety incidents at athletic events around the county.

For fall sports, UCPS will implement the following protocols.

- Only clear bags, no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" will be allowed in events/games. Medical and baby bags are subject to search.
- Middle and elementary students must be accompanied by an adult (21 years or older) to attend events and games.
- All ticket sales will end at the beginning of halftime or at the mid-point of an event.
- After consulting with law enforcement and district leaders, UCPS will utilize body scanners at events. The use of body scanners will begin in the fall of 2024 at football games.

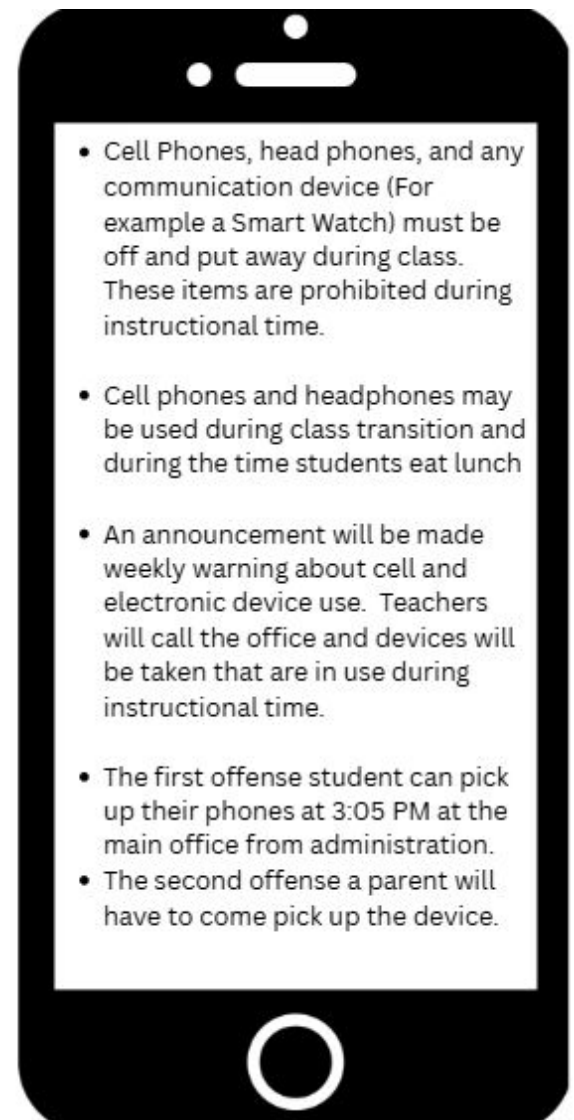
