CAREER PLANS

On 5/21/2025 parents should have received an email directly from Major Clarity containing their student's career plan. This email will be sent to the parent email address currently on file in PowerSchool.

Per our communication from the beginning of the school year, NC Senate Bill 193 requires that all students in grades 6-12 have a career plan. A student's initial career plan will be created (by the student) by the end of their 6th grade year and then revised annually through 12th grade. UCPS utilized Major Clarity as the platform for students to create their career plan.

Students only focused on completing three areas this year: Assessments, Pathway Selection & Academic Planning. If further information was added to your students career plan it was due to your student inputting that data. The career plan is a fluid document and does not dictate your students future plans. This is a guide for your student to utilize as they progress through high school

As was shared in the email to parents sent on 5/20/2025, *one important part of career planning is academic planning. Please note that the courses listed in your student's career plan are for planning and exploration purposes only. **The courses listed in the career plan do not reflect your student's 2025-2026 schedule.***

Students can update the courses in the career plan at any time by accessing Major Clarity as they continue to explore the course offerings related to their future career interests. Information

regarding official student schedules for the 2025-2026 school year will be sent out in August of 2025.

Please communicate with your student about their career plan as they are the editor of the document you received. For course selections please communicate with your students counselor in August 2025 prior to the start of the 2025-2026 school year.

SECOND SEMESTER FINAL EXAM INFORMATION

EOC and Teacher Made Final Exams Begin Monday, June 2nd.

Students are required to take all exams, including End of Course (EOC), State CTE, and Teacher Made Exams, at school during exam week. EOC classes include **English II, Math I, Math III and Biology**. The following CTE classes also have required state exams:

- Health Science I Honors
- Business Essentials I Honors
- Business Essentials I Honors UCPS – Virtual
- Foods and Nutrition I Honors
- Culinary Arts and Hospitality I Honors

The exam schedule is as follows:

- Monday, June 2nd - **1st Block Exams**
- Tuesday, June 3rd - **2nd Block Exams**
- Wednesday, June 4th - **3rd Block Exams**
- Thursday, June 5th - **4th Block Exams**
- Friday, June 6th - **Make-Up Exams**

Per UCPS policy, all final exams will count as 25% of a student's overall semester grade.


The following are some important reminders for all students taking an EOC, CTE, or teacher made final exam:

- Students are asked to charge their Chromebook the night before AND bring their charger with them for test day. If your students computer is broken or not working properly, please have them contact Ms. Tammy Douglas, our Desktop Support Engineer.
- Students should bring a pencil and calculator if they have a math exam.
- Testing will begin at 8:15am on Monday, June 2nd through Thursday, June 5th as well as on Friday, June 6th for the make-up exams. All testing should be completed daily around 12:30pm. **Students will not be permitted to leave campus until all exams have been completed.**
- Buses will pick up at normal morning times on exam days but will be taking students home immediately following exams during those days. Buses will run on normal times during the make-up exam day on Friday, June 6th. Only students who have to take a make-up exam are required to come to school on the make-up exam day on Friday, June 6th.

Completing state exams are a requirement for all students enrolled in those courses. If you have any concerns or questions please contact assistant principal and WHS testing coordinator, Mrs. Alanna Smith, via email (Alanna.smith@ucps.k12.nc.us) or by calling the school.

Senior Cap and Gown Picture: Monday, May 19th 8:15 am

Seniors will be taking a class Cap and Gown picture on Monday, May 19th. All seniors will report directly to the stadium no later than 8:00 am. All seniors will need to bring their cap and gown. Following the picture, the senior class will walk through Weddington Elementary school and Weddington Middle school in their cap and gown. All seniors will report to class after the walk-through.

Graduation Rehearsal: Friday, June 6th 12:00pm

All seniors participating in commencement are required to attend rehearsal on Friday, June 6th at 12:00pm. Students should report to the auditorium starting at 11:15am for check-in. Students will receive their cords and 8 graduation tickets. All fees must be paid in full before students can receive their tickets. Students cannot pick up tickets for other students.

IMPORTANT: Physical tickets MUST be presented at the commencement in order for entry. NO ADDITIONAL TICKETS WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE.

Senior Collections:

Seniors will not be allowed to receive their tickets if their school account has not been cleared. Please check PowerSchool to see if your student has any unpaid fees. If you have any questions regarding fees, please feel free to reach out to our bookkeeper, Tina Starnes at tinat.starnes@ucps.k12.nc.us. She will be available during graduation rehearsal to assist students with clearing any outstanding fees. **It is extremely important that all seniors ensure that they have**

turned in all textbooks, library materials, Chromebook and charger, and any outstanding fees by the end of the day Friday, June 6th.

Graduation: Monday, June 9th at 8:00am

Weddington High School's Class of 2025 Commencement will be held on Monday, June 9th at 8:00am at the high school stadium. Seniors are expected to arrive and line up by 7:15am. Students may park in the student parking lot as early as 7:00am, check in at the table in the gym, and then proceed to their assigned pod for line up. We will begin the processional at 7:45am. It is extremely important that students arrive by 7:15am in order to ensure they are able to check in and be in line for the procession.

Dress code for students is business casual. Males should wear dress pants and a collared shirt and females a dress, skirt, or dress pants. Flip Flops should not be worn. Ladies should not wear heels as they will be walking on soft grass. Ladies should affix the white collar that comes with the graduation gown. All cords will be distributed at graduation rehearsal. Only school distributed cords may be worn. Graduation caps are not to be decorated.

Inclement Weather Contingency Plan:

Graduation will take place Monday, June 9th at 8:00am as planned, however, it is possible that there could be a minor delay or modification to the program depending on the weather. We will continue monitoring the weather throughout the week and over the weekend prior to graduation. Any delays to the 8:00am start time would be communicated Monday morning by no later than 6:00am via a connect ed text message and through our school social media platforms. Students, parents, and guests are encouraged to follow Weddington High School social media the morning of graduation for any updates.

Graduation Live Stream:

Graduation will be Live Streamed as in years past. The link for the Live Stream will be shared with families the week prior to graduation.

Graduation Tickets:

Each graduating senior will receive 8 tickets to the ceremony. **Each student will receive the 8 physical tickets on rehearsal day.** Students are more than welcome to ask other students for any unused tickets. However, WHS will not facilitate this process or provide additional tickets. There will be three entry points for all guests: Weddington Middle School, Weddington Elementary School, and the Weddington High School student lot.

All guests will need a ticket in order to attend. Children who are 5 years and younger do not need a ticket, however, they must sit on a parents lap. We ask that you please have your paper ticket ready upon arriving at the ticket booth. The gates will open at 7:00am. All guests are encouraged to arrive early to ensure you get a parking spot and find a seat prior to the ceremony beginning promptly at 8:00am.

Safety Protocols for UCPS Events:

Per UCPS safety protocols, only clear bags, no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" will be allowed into graduation. All guests are asked to plan accordingly as this will be enforced. After consulting with law enforcement and district officials, UCPS reserves the right to utilize body scanners at events. Metal detectors will be used at all stadium entrances. Please plan your arrival accordingly.

Graduation Parking:


Parking is available at Weddington Elementary, Weddington Middle and Weddington High School. We highly encourage guests to park at the elementary and middle school lots due to their close proximity.

Although there are handicap parking spots at each of the parking locations, all individuals requiring additional assistance are asked to park at Weddington Middle School. There will be a golf cart shuttle for those who need assistance. Handicap loading/unloading will occur in the handicap spots in the front middle school lot.

Due to the number of guests attending graduation, parking will be limited. Families are encouraged to carpool and maximize the number of guests per vehicle.


CHROMEBOOK COLLECTION FOR ALL STUDENTS

All students will turn in their Chromebook and charger this year at the conclusion of their last exam. If students do not have final exams, they will need to turn in their Chromebook and charger by Friday, May 30th to Mrs. Douglas or Mrs. Waldrup in the media center. For students who have final exams, they will need to turn in their Chromebook and charger at the end of the exam period for their last exam. All collections will take place in the media center immediately after each exam period until 2 pm.

If you notice any damage, **you must complete a Chromebook Damage Statement**. These forms are available in the Media Center. You can also ask a teacher or staff member to print one for you, as a copy will be emailed to all staff members. **Submitting this form is required by Technology Services. Failure to submit a damage statement may result in being charged for repairs.**

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. Will my PowerSchool parent account username/password transfer to Infinite Campus?
A. No. Parents will need to create a new account with Infinite Campus.

Q. When will parents have access to Infinite Campus?
A. Parents will receive an email in mid to late July with information on how to create an account and then gain access to their student's information.

Q. Will I need an account for each student?
A. Parents will only need one account to see their student's information.

Q. Will students receive a new ID number?
A. No, student ID numbers will not change.

Q. How will parents access the new portal?
A. The Infinite Campus portal can be accessed via a cell phone or computer.

Q. What can parents do to help with the transition?
A. If your contact information has changed this school year, contact your child's school to update your address and contact information.

Q. What happens if my contact information changes this summer?
A. Parents will have the option to change their contact information and emergency contacts when the parent portal opens.

Q. When will more information become available about the parent portal?
A. Parents will receive more details during open houses, back-to-school events and in school newsletters and emails.

STUDENT ABSENCE PORTAL

In the event your child is absent from school due to illness/injury, please upload your documentation to the [Student Absence Portal](#). The proper documentation MUST be provided in order to excuse the absence. A phone call to the school, stating your student is absent, is not necessary. Remember, parent notes will only be accepted during the current 6-week grading period, of the absent day.

ATTENDANCE FAQ



What do I need to do if my student needs to leave early?

Send them to school with a parent note stating their name and what time they need to be dismissed. They will bring their note to the front office and receive an early dismissal slip.

Do I need to come into the school to sign out my student?

If they brought in a note - NO.
If they did not bring in a note - YES.

What if my student drives and needs to unexpectedly leave early?

We will need WRITTEN permission for your student to check themselves out. Please email the front office.

When do I need to use the Student Absence Portal?

Anytime your student is absent. Doctor's notes should **only** be uploaded to the portal - we do not need the paper copy.

When does my excuse note need to be uploaded?

Requested within 24 hours of the absence. Deadline for ALL excuse notes is before the end of each 6 week grading period.

Can I use the Student Absence Portal for an early dismissal?

NO. Students need to bring in a physical note in order to receive an early dismissal slip.

What is the latest time I can pick up my student?

We do not have a cutoff time, however, we suggest arriving before 2:30, as the car rider line tends to become congested.

What absences can be considered excused?


With appropriate documentation: medical appointments, illness (5 parent-excused per semester), DMV (1 per year), approved college visits (juniors & seniors)





VISITORS/DROP OFFS

All visitors to the school must enter through the front doors of the school using the video doorbell system. All visitors must check in at the main office during the hours of 7:30 am and 4:00 pm, which are the main office hours on days that school is in session.

Forgotten Items/Drop Offs/Deliveries:

- items can be placed on the drop-off cart located outside the front doors
- items will be brought inside before the end of each block and placed on the table in the foyer

UCPS EVENT PROTOCOL

! NEW PROTOCOLS FOR UCPS EVENTS

UCPS has experienced a number of safety incidents at athletic events around the county.

For fall sports, UCPS will implement the following protocols.

- Only clear bags, no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" will be allowed in events/games. Medical and baby bags are subject to search.
- Middle and elementary students must be accompanied by an adult (21 years or older) to attend events and games.
- All ticket sales will end at the beginning of halftime or at the mid-point of an event.
- After consulting with law enforcement and district leaders, UCPS will utilize body scanners at events. The use of body scanners will begin in the fall of 2024 at football games.
