# Second Semester Begins Monday, January 30th

Students will follow their 2nd semester schedule beginning Monday, January 30th. **Students are** asked to review their schedule in PowerSchool prior to coming to school on Monday. Paper copies of second semester schedules will not be distributed.

Students are asked to please check PowerSchool throughout the weekend to ensure they are aware of their most up-to-date schedule. Some classes may have changed as staff have continued to balance out classes over the weekend. If you have a hole or a "please see your counselor" message on your schedule for first block, please remain in the cafeteria after the tardy bell rings. School counselors will be available to assist in selecting a course to fill this hole. If a student is still waiting on a schedule change request, they are asked to please report to the class that is currently on their schedule. Counselors are continuing to work on schedule change requests.

**Please note:** A schedule change request does not guarantee a schedule change. The schedule change request link for the first five days of semester 2 will be sent out on Monday. Students are advised to check Canvas announcements as well as their email for the link.

# SPCC/Approved FLEX students: Key Fob Information

Semester 2 approved SPCC/Flex students will need to pick up their Key Fob from Mrs. Yost at the Attendance Office on Monday, January 30th. Please allow yourself extra time when you stop by, as their most likely will be a line. Semester 1 Key Fobs will need to be reactivated as well. If you have a Fob and are no longer an approved SPCC/Flex student, you are required to turn in your Fob to avoid the assigned fee.

# Second Semester Open House



The spring semester Open House/Curriculum Night will be held on Wednesday, **February 15th, at 5:30 pm**. All parents are asked to report directly to your child's first period class. The event will begin promptly at 5:30pm with first period teachers showing a virtual message from Dr. Kraftson and the WHS PTSO. After the message from Dr. Kraftson and the PTSO, parents will follow their student's schedule beginning with first period for a 10 minute presentation from the teacher. This will be an opportunity for teachers to provide an overview of their course content and class expectations.

# Class of 2023 - Midyear Transcript / Midyear Report/ Midyear Grades - Request

Not all colleges/universities require a midyear transcript/midyear report. Check your email, review admissions pages, and login to your college portals to identify if this documentation is required. This <a href="mailto:form">form</a> (<a href="https://forms.gle/gmFEo6ZJZyb9sEUK6">https://forms.gle/gmFEo6ZJZyb9sEUK6</a>) should only be completed for those schools requesting or requiring a midyear transcript/midyear report.

Once Semester 1 exams have concluded and grades are finalized, the District will load final Semester 1 transcripts. This process could take up to 3 days. Please allow 2 weeks for transcripts to be submitted.

Only midyear transcripts requested via this document will be sent to colleges/universities. Email/voicemail requests will not be processed.

Check your SCOIR account for updates.

#### Semester 2 - Schedule Change Request

- 1. Schedule change requests can be submitted Wednesday, December 1st Friday, February 3rd.
- 2. Modifications to schedules began Monday, December 12th and conclude Friday, February 3rd.
- 3. ONLY requests submitted via this <u>form</u> (<u>https://forms.gle/c3C3bdBYxdGEmruV6</u>) will be considered.
- 4. Requests sent via email and/or voicemail will NOT be considered.
- 5. Please know submitting this form does NOT guarantee a schedule change.
- 6. Do not submit this form if you do not want the order of your current schedule to change, as this is a possibility.
- 7. Check PowerSchool often to identify if a modification to your schedule has been made.
- 8. Schedule changes are made in real time therefore a list of options cannot be made available.



#### IMPORTANT REMINDERS

### Arrival and Dismissal

As we begin the second semester, we want to share a few reminders with arrival and dismissal. We continue to encourage students and parents to allow extra time to get to school in the morning to ensure they are on time. We kindly ask that students are not dropped off or picked up in the student parking lot or in the bus lot. Only students with a valid parking pass will be permitted to park in the student parking lot.



Students are not to park in the church parking lot across from the school or on the streets in surrounding neighborhoods. All student drop-offs in the morning and pick-ups at dismissal are to be done in the car rider line. We also ask that all cars pull all the way down in the car rider line as directed by staff. This allows more students to access their rides at one time, thereby speeding up the pick-up process.



# Drop Off Table

Should a student need an item brought from home, parents are permitted to do so. There is a drop-off table inside the main foyer. The school will not be responsible for any items left in this drop-off area. Classes will not be interrupted for pick-ups. Make sure to label them with your child's first and last name. Food drop-offs by parents or outside delivery services (such as Door Dash, Uber Eats, etc.) will not be permitted. Please plan ahead for events such as a forgotten lunch by arranging to have a balance in the student's cafeteria account. No other deliveries will be accepted for students...this includes flowers and other gifts.
