This year the North Carolina Center for the Advancement of Teaching (NCCAT) will present the 2nd annual NCCAT Career and Technical Education Teacher of the Year Award. The NCCAT Career and Technical Education Teacher of the Year process was developed to honor Career and Technical Education teachers and retain excellent teachers in North Carolina public schools. The NCCAT CTE Teacher of the Year will earn \$5,000, an opportunity to attend the state ACTE conference and instructional supply funds for the teacher's school.


## SENIORS...JOIN US FOR MUSIC BINGO!

On November 8, Union County residents will vote on \$134,405,000 million in school bonds to address aging facilities. This bond package will replace current buildings at East Elementary and Forest Hills High, schools that were built in the 1950s and 1960s. The 2022 bond will build on previous investments and provide adequate facilities for students and staff.

Can I create my student's ad on my mobile device? Yes, yearbook ads can be created online from both desktop and mobile devices.


#### Can I send my materials to the school?
