September-November

- Update Resumes & Complete Brag Sheet Survey in SCOIR
- Sign FERPA waiver- in SCOIR and Common App
- Take Fall SAT/ACT exams
- Check for DEADLINES
 - Early Applications
 - Scholarships
- Begin application process
- Request Recommendations
- FAFSA Opens on or before December 1st
 - use income/tax information from 2023



College Applications

- Includes:
 - \circ Application
 - Letters of Rec, Essays
 - Application Fee (or Fee Waiver)
 - Official SAT/ACT scores (if required)
 - Transcript
 - MUST move college(s) to "Applying To" list in Scoir
 - Choose correct application deadline! (Early Action vs. Regular Decision)
 - Residency Number (if required)

 - **DO NOT enter your counselor's email address in common app–just their name
- <u>CFNC</u>– College Foundation of North Carolina, <u>www.cfnc.org</u>
 - College search, applying to college
 - Must still list colleges in Scoir
- Individual college websites
 - Separate student portal





- Platform used by counselors and teachers to send transcripts, letters of recommendation, and additional supporting documents to colleges
- Notify counselors and teachers by adding schools you are applying to in the "applying to" or "applied" column in SCOIR
 - Otherwise we will not know to send your documents
- Sign off on FERPA-waiver of rights and release authorization














FERPA: "Me"--> "View Profile" Grant "Release Authorization" and "Waiver of Rights"




Letters of Recommendation

- Ask <u>at least 2 weeks</u> before the recommendation is due
- Invite them in SCOIR
- Provide recommender with necessary information
 - Brag Sheet Survey (located in SCOIR)
 - Resume
- <u>Be specific</u> or they will write generic recommendations!
- *Be intentional* about who you ask

- 5. When finished, click "Send."



Residency Determination Service (RDS) www.ncresidency.org

- North Carolina Residency 12 month resident
- Online application for all students applying to a NC college that are seeking:
 - In-state tuition
 - NC state grant for financial aid
- Not a resident don't try to claim residency!
- Public & Private colleges
- Students will be given a Residency Certification Number (RCN) to enter on applications



Financial Aid

- 2 Main Types of Financial Aid
 - Need-Based Aid
 - Merit-Based Aid
- 4 Ways Financial Aid is Given
 - Scholarships
 - Grants
 - Work-Study
 - Loans
- Must complete FAFSA to qualify for financial aid!
- Net Price Calculators



How To Apply for Financial Aid

• Free Application for Federal Student Aid

- Opens in Dec.
- Based on 2023 tax forms
- <u>www.fafsa.gov</u>
- Complete the CSS Financial Aid Profile
 - Opens Dec
 - Only 5 schools in NC: Duke, Davidson, Wake Forest, Chapel Hill, Elon

NC Promise

- Four schools in North Carolina participate in the NC Promise program which significantly reduces tuition to \$500 per semester.
 - Elizabeth City State University
 - Fayetteville State University
 - The University of North Carolina at Pembroke
 - Western Carolina University



Next NC Scholarship

- Financial aid program for households making \$80,000 (AGI) or less
 - FULLY covering tuition/fees at ANY NC community college
 - Minimum of at least \$3000
 - Covers half, if not all, of tuition and fees at any public university in the state (% varies based on tuition/fees at the school)
 - (minimum of \$5,000)
- Students apply by submitting the FAFSA.
 - If eligible, they'll receive the Next NC Scholarship
 - No additional forms to complete

SPCC Gateway Scholarship

- Gateway To Wingate
 - Earn a 2 year Associate's Degree with SPCC
 - Maintain a 2.5 GPA
 - Transfer to Wingate University and have tuition capped at \$2,500 or less
 - Road 2 Wingate
 - Start this transfer program in 1st semester, 100% of your credits will transfer
 - Guaranteed admission

SCHOLARSHIP RESOURCES

- Institutional Scholarships
 - Check college website for any separate scholarship applications and deadlines
- Local Scholarships
 - County, SVHS, or Community specific
 - Listen for scholarship announcements!
- Search for scholarships
 - Check out resources on <u>College Advising Website</u>
 - Report any scholarships to the College Adviser!
 - Not just those you accept but ANY you are offered

SAT & ACT

- If you need to improve test scores, sign up immediately
- If you are going to a community college \rightarrow you <u>do not need to</u> take the SAT or ACT
- <u>Most colleges will accept either SAT or ACT scores</u> → no preference & weigh scores equally
- Many North Carolina schools are test optional for the upcoming school year
- Students with a weighted High School GPA greater than or equal to 2.50 and less than 2.80 are <u>required</u> to submit a standardized test score (ACT or SAT) for UNC-system schools
- <u>Fee Waivers are available for students on free or reduced lunch!</u> Stop by the Counseling Suite

Community Colleges

- South Piedmont Community College (SPCC) and Central Piedmont Community College (CPCC)
- Open admission
 - NO minimum GPA or foreign language requirements
 - NO SAT or ACT test requirement
- <u>2 year college option</u> that can lead to:
 - Associates of Art or Science (TRANSFER) \rightarrow degree that is designed for transfer
 - SPCC guaranteed admissions partnerships-
 - APP state, ECU, Mars Hill, NC A&T, Wesleyan, UNC Asheville, UNC Wilmington, Wingate, Winston Salem State
 - CPCC guaranteed admissions partnerships-
 - APP state, ECU, Johnson C. Smith, Lees McRae, Meredith, Queens University, UNC-CH, UNC-C, UNC-W, Western, Wingate

**Apply AND send transcripts for free through CFNC

Military Options

- Different military branches visit SVHS throughout the year
- <u>The ASVAB test is REQUIRED</u> (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) for entrance into the military
- SVHS will offer the ASVAB test 8 times this year!
 - Fall: September 19, October 17, November 21, December 19
 - Spring: February 21, March 20, April 17, May 14
 - Sign up in ROTC Classroom Room 128/130
