- Site-Based Operations
 - AdvancED District Accreditation
 - School Level Committees- Basden discussed that the lists of committee members would be forth coming.
 - Chairs- Committees will meet soon to vote on a chair person.
- PRHS Instruction
 - ACT Testing- Basden spoke of the March 6, 2012 ACT testing day. Every junior in the state took the ACT on the same day. The 5 hour test went smoothly with the planning done by the Guidance department.
 - Staffing / Budget 2012/2013- We watched a video by Dr. Davis on the projected 2012-2013 school year. The video highlighted Union county's successes since 2008-2009 despite the recession. It explained where the money comes from, where it is being spent and what could happen in the future.  - Basden explained that PRHS is expected to grow by at least 70 students.
- PRHS Operations- Basden spoke on each topic.
 - Budget 2011/2012 Spending Deadline- Although the spending has dropped, PRHS had more than anticipated. The money was given to departments and some was set aside for instructional purposes.
 - PRHS wireless update- Smart Boards are in every classroom. Some of the laptops are in need of updating. The county is looking into ways of keeping non-UCPS issued devices from using the wireless connections.

All students will go to homeroom on March 16, 2012 to receive their usernames and passwords. Online registration will end on Spring break.
