Several tools are available for communication - classroom dojo, Edmodo, sawyer - there are 4-5 platforms out there for use. Meaningful tools in parents hands - parents want to know when their student has the first silent lunch rather than hearing about it later. This is a way for students to also see the positive communications.
Teacher Walkout	5 min	Mr. Sanders	Scheduled teacher walkout 5/16. To make congress etc aware of the struggles teachers face. Money for schools. Rally in Raleigh, 1 st day back for legislation. Teachers will be marching. Currently have 300 middle school teachers have put in for personal leave. 700 across the district at this time. CMS has

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			cancelled their day of school for then due to number of teachers out. Union County is currently monitoring. EUMS has 13 teachers that are taking that day as a personal day. If a teacher calls out sick - documentation is required from a Dr. for it to be taken as a sick day or will pay \$50 for their day taken. EUMS will be operating to the best of our ability.
Boys and Girls Club	10 min	Mr. Sanders	We host the B&G club. The number of consistent middle school students is only 3. Proposal is that the B&G club will operate out of Wingate Elementary instead of at EUMS. EU students will ride the bus to the B&G club. Meeting will happen with Mr. Maxie Johnson (Wingate Elemetary), director of B&G, Mr. Leon and Mr. Sanders.
2018-2019 Calendar	10 min	Mr. Sanders	Calendar has been approved for awhile now. We are an EPIC school that receives money for a variety of purposes. August 13-14 will be paid from EPIC grant for teachers who participate. Would like the teachers to take part in CHAMPS training – anyone who falls into category as a "teacher" would be eligible. Team building – AG center and partnering with Monroe middle. Commitment contracts will be talked about for these days. There is a tiered system where teachers/students will know consequences for behaviors. CHAMPS is more of the classroom management – expectations are set, discipline will still follow UCPS policy.
