# **Principal's Report**

- Positive beginning of the school year, successful open house especially with freshmen and seniors
- School performance:
  - CATA remain outstanding in all aspect according to the latest data:
  - Especially proud of increase in Math 1 proficiency >3 %, and ACT proficiency increase >5%
  - Very slight decline in biology proficiency but still stay in A.
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Teacher survey data: 98% considered CATA to be a good place to teach
  - We are encouraged by the athletic season as we are getting more competitive. Need to get more fan support to our games
  - Our enrollment numbers are good, 226 freshmen this year. Total student number this year is close to 900 now.
  - o Dance/collision/IB have unclaimed spots this year for enrollment.

  - Investment for excellence: nearly \$4,000
  - Sports: over \$10,000

- Fundraising
  - Jersey Mike– Sports Committee contact Jersey Mike for Homecoming Week sponsorship (banner, serving JM sandwiches in the concessions, etc)
- Hospitality
  - Tissue/Candy drive sign-up genius set up
  - Amazon link option also to be added to the tissue/candy drive sign-up genius email and social media communications
- Senior
  - o 2 successful events for seniors:
    - Parking Lot Painting Party: well attended with expenses of \$226.83
    - First Day of School: roughly 1/3 seniors participated; expenses \$148.60
  - Need a better system for providing info to the seniors, especially those who flex: Announce/poster can be used to communicate senior events, in addition to the email to parents
- Sports
  - We have non-athletic student volunteer to support on crochet items, and a parent support with earrings
  - Try to advertising the Sports Pass (\$40) that covers all sports events. That will be cost saving and get more people to the sports events.
  - Need to work on ideas to get more people to CATA sports event, especially for travel games that are not played at CATA.
  - Next vote in 2 weeks on point-of-sale or free phone+ data for concession stands
  - o Concession stands to serve food for volleyball games as the players need to eat right after the games
  - o Need more volunteers to do fundraising and events for sports committee
  - Targeted communications to bring more freshmen parents on board with the sports events and volunteer needs
  - Attendance policy is updated regarding athletics' eligibility to attend sports
