Discipline: 68 February referrals compared to 65 in September; most referrals are in the middle of the day-especially 3rd block; most common Insubordination, Unauthorized Area; Cutting Class; Aggressive Behavior; 497 total referrals this year; Math leads with the most 16%, non-instructional 16%, Science 15%, CTE 14%, SS 13%, English 11%, FL 6%, Art 4%, PE 2%; 161 from 10th grade, 152 9th grade, 141 11th grade, 68 12th grade; Behavior Plan has to be in place for a student to be sent to an alternative learning program2. Proficiency: WorkKeys Assessment will be administered tomorrow to 30-40 students a silver/gold/platinum on the WorkKeys can take the place of a student who scores less than a 19 on ACT to get a proficient - student also receives a completer for the student in an area; WIDA has been lowered from a 4.7 to a 4.5 to get exited-that is happening; College Board has just lowered the proficient ACT score back to a 17 (this will affect the juniors - class of 26); Math 3 scores really strong-Donnelly 96% proficiency!3.
